### Rules & Regulations

General	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- The competition will use as guidelines, the rules and regulations of the <u><i>Thailand Equestrian Federation (TEF)</i></u> for Dressage and Show Jumping; and, <u><i>Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI)</i></u> for the FEI WJC Challenge, unless otherwise stated. In case of any <b>dispute or protest</b>, aside for the World Jumping Challenge, the <b>organizer and judges</b> has the right to give the final decision regardless of the rules.</li> <li>- When <u><i>riding</i></u>, all riders are expected to wear standard <u><i>helmets</i></u> as per FEI Rules.</li> <li>- The competition grounds and stables are to be kept clean and tidy at all times. A <u><i>BHT 500 fee</i></u> will be collected if the stall and its surroundings are not cleaned up before departure. For safety reasons, be extra careful when using electrical wires and appliances. There is <u><i>NO smoking or cooking in the stables</i></u>, or, where flammable materials exist (i.e. hay and bedding storage areas).</li> <li>- <u><i>Traffic rules and regulations</i></u> will be implemented and must be followed by all competitors and guests during the competition. <b>Horses</b> always have the <b>right of way</b>.</li> <li>- All <b>dogs</b> <i>must</i> be kept on <b>leash</b> at all times.</li> </ul>
Vaccinations and EIA Certificate	- All horses must have an <u><i>EIA</i></u> and <u><i>Surra</i></u> certificate with a <u><i>negative</i></u> result not older than <b>three (3) months</b> . We require that all competing horses must be vaccinated against <u><i>Equine Influenza</i></u> (Flu shot every 6 months). We recommend that all horses are vaccinated against <u><i>Japanese B Encephalitis (JEE)</i></u> and <u><i>Tetanus</i></u> , and <u><i>dewormed</i></u> regularly. This is for the well-being of all horses travelling to competition.
Horse Numbers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- <u><i>Horse Identification Numbers</i></u> will be distributed on the arrival of horses. Please pick it up from the Riding School Office/Tack Shop. Horses leaving the stables to train or compete must have their numbers at all times.</li> <li>- A <u><i>BHT 50.00</i></u> replacement fee, for each number, will be charged, if the rider requires replacement due to lost horse number.</li> </ul>
Prize Giving and Classes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Winners should attend the prize giving ceremony mounted unless otherwise stated.</li> <li>- <u><i>Prize Money, Trophies</i></u>, and <u><i>Sponsored Products</i></u> will be awarded in <u><i>selected classes</i></u> and will be <u><i>based on the number of entries</i></u>. <u><i>Ribbons</i></u> will be awarded to all placers in all the classes. <b>1 placing</b> every <b>4 competitors</b>, maximum placing per class is on the schedule. <b>3 riders/entries make a class</b> – less than 3, class will be cancelled.</li> </ul>

## Entries

<b>Closing Dates</b>	- Entries must be received by fax or email on or before <b><i>Monday, 16 May 2016</i></b> , until 17:00 p.m.
<b>Late Entries</b>	- If time and space allows, late entries will be accepted until <b><i>Wednesday, 18 May 2016</i></b> on or before 12:00 noon. All <b>late entries</b> will be charged an <b>additional BHT 100.00</b> on top of the applicable entry fee. A <b>penalty of BHT 50.00</b> will be charged <b>for entry changes</b> and <b>withdrawals</b> .
<b>Entry Fees</b>	- Entry fees must be <b>paid</b> at the Riding School Office at least <b>2 hours before</b> the start of the <b>class</b> .
<b>Departure</b>	- Before your horse will be permitted to leave Horseshoe Point, a <b><i>Payment Slip</i></b> or <b><i>Invoice</i></b> must be obtained from the Riding School Office, signed by an authorized person, and with an <b>official stamp</b> . This will only be issued once all accounts have been settled and must be shown to the <b>Stable Supervisor</b> for checking and signing. It must be presented to the security at the gate before they will allow any horse to leave.
<b>Release of Liability</b>	- <b>Participation</b> in this event signifies an <b>agreement</b> to the <b>General Release</b> . The competitors may be photographed, interviewed, and videos taken; which, the organizer and sponsor may use for their own advertising purposes and at their own discretion.

I understand and agree that the International Riding School and Horseshoe Point is not responsible for any act, occurrence, or element of nature that can scare, endanger or cause harm to a horse, causing it to react in an unsafe manner.

I understand and agree that by using the facility at the International Riding School and Horseshoe Point, I have to repair or reimburse the International Riding School and Horseshoe Point for all expenses which include materials and time in the event of any damage to stables, equipment, jumps, arenas, or any part of the property that is damaged by my horse(s) or myself.

I understand and agree that inhumane treatment of the horse(s) or repeated unsafe acts will immediately void all agreements and I will forfeit all rights to access this premises.

I understand that the International Riding School and Horseshoe Point shall not be liable for any untoward incident and injury to the horse(s) or damage to any personal property should my horse(s) escape from the enclosures while inside the property.

And I fully understand that I will be personally responsible for any damages and/or injuries to other person or their belongings and properties, that is either caused by me, my dependent(s), my employee(s), and my horse(s) .
