

Map 1: Location map of Ramganj Police Station







FIGURE 1: Molestation crime in 2009 in Ramganj



FIGURE 2: Women crime in 2010 in Ramganj



FIGURE 3: Women crime in 2011 in Ramganj




Figure 3 shows that Molestation against women is the highest in number in 2011 which is 21 and lowest number of crime against women is Cruelty by husband & relatives that is 1.

FIGURE 4: Women crimes in 2011 & 2012 in Ramganj




Figure 4 shows that different crime against women in 2011 & 2012 where it is observed the Molestation is highest which is 60% and lowest crime is Rape against women is 9%.
