

Terms and Conditions for the Jingle/Caller tunes contest

1. The **Jingle/Caller tunes** Contest is being organized by Ministry of AYUSH.
2. The contest shall remain open till **23:59 hrs (IST) on 9th June 2018**. Entries received outside of these dates will not be valid.
3. Entry into the contest is open to eligible entrants only. An eligible entrant is one who is a resident of Indian origin aged 10 years or over. Proof of age and identity will be required.
4. All entries must be submitted on www.mygov.in. Entries submitted through any other medium/ mode will not be considered for evaluation.
5. Participant(s) is/are required to ensure that his/her **MyGov profile** is accurate and updated since Ministry of AYUSH would be using this for further communication. This includes details such as **Name, Photo, Email-id, Address and Phone number**. Entries with incomplete profiles will not be considered.
6. Entries may be submitted online on **www.mygov.in** latest by 9th June, 2018.
7. The entry must not contain any provocative, objectionable or inappropriate content.
8. Once submitted an entry cannot be withdrawn.
9. One entrant can participate only once. Multiple entries from the same entrant will not be considered and will be discarded.
10. Organisers will not accept any responsibility for entries that are lost, are late or incomplete or have not been transmitted due to computer error or any other error beyond the organiser's reasonable control. Please note proof of submission of the entry is not proof of receipt of the same.
11. The first three entries drawn at random from all eligible and fully correct entries received will be the declared winners and next 2 will be declared as consolation winners.

12. Prizes for participants:

Prize for winner:	INR 31000/-
Second prize for Runner up:	INR 21000/-
Third prize for Second runner up:	INR 11000/-
Consolation Prize (2)	INR 5100/-

13. Each of the winners will be notified through telephone and or the email address

that they provided along with their submission.

14. All winners will get a merit certificate from Ministry of AYUSH.
15. The prize money will be transferred through RTGS.
16. If a winner is not contactable within three working days from the result announcement, he or she will forfeit the prize and another winner will be selected from the remaining eligible entries in accordance with the above process until a winner is selected and can be contacted.
17. In the event of unforeseen circumstances, organisers reserve the right to amend or withdraw the Contest at any time. For the avoidance of doubt this includes the right to amend these terms and conditions.
18. By entering the Contest the Entrant accepts and agrees to be bound by these Terms and Conditions.
19. The Participant shall abide by all the rules and regulations of participating in the Contest from time to time.
20. Organisers reserve all rights to disqualify or refuse participation to any participant if they deem participation or association of any participant shall be detrimental to the Contest or the Organisers or partners of the Contest. The registrations shall be void if the information received by the Organisers is illegible, incomplete, damaged, false or erroneous.
21. Organisers' decision on the Contest shall be final and binding and no correspondence will be entered into regarding the same.

Specifications of Jingle

1. The Jingle should be of 3 to 5 minutes' duration with lyrics, composition and music. The jingle shall be in simple lucid language in either English or Hindi easily understood by the people.
2. The jingle shall capture the essence of Yoga.
3. Entry must be submitted to the **Creative Corner Section** of MyGov portal. The participants should provide the following information as part of their entry: Description about the submission within 200 characters, such as names of the lyricist, composer, singer, etc.
4. The participants should then upload their entry as a high quality audio file to any media platform such as **SoundCloud, YouTube, Google Drive, Dropbox** etc. and enter the publicly accessible link in the comments section.



5. Ministry of AYUSH may ask for the original and uncompressed audio file, if so required, in separate communication.
6. All entries would be judged by a Committee constituted by the Ministry of AYUSH. The decision of the Committee would be final.
7. The Selected entry and its copyright will be the property of the Ministry of AYUSH and any changes deemed fit to improve the same will be undertaken.
