- Participants can participate in the contest by registering on the **My Gov** platform and uploading the suggested name on the creative corner.
- Participant is to make sure that his/her **MyGov** profile is accurate and updated since Ministry would be using this for further communication. This includes details such as name, e-mail id, photo and mobile number. Entries with incomplete profiles would not be considered.
- Once submitted for competition, copyrights of the name will be with Department of Posts.
- No limit on number of entries.
- **Winner will be conferred with a certificate and air economy/ 2AC ticket reimbursement will be provided from their home to place of prize distribution.**

- You must be the sole author/ owner of the copyright of the name suggested and the names should not have been previously utilised for any other purpose.

- All entries will be judged based on creativity, originality and composition by Department of Posts.

- Department of Posts reserves the right to reject any entry, which it does not feel, suitable or appropriate or which does not conform to any of the conditions listed above.
