



## SCHOLARSHIPS

*Below are the requirements for each type of scholarship.*

**Students from countries underrepresented or not represented at RIS. This scholarship is offered year-round, on a rolling admissions basis.**

### **Diversity Scholarship**

- Students need to have a grade-point average of 3.00 or above and/or equivalent standardized test results
- Students should display qualities of character and maturity
- Students will receive an annual reduction in tuition fees as follows: 10% for ES, 20% for MS, and 30% for HS.
- To qualify for this scholarship, both parents need to be non-Thai passport holders

**Applications for the following scholarships will be accepted between January and March 2020. All new applicants are eligible to apply. Current RIS students who have demonstrated exceptional academic or artistic achievement have the opportunity to apply one time only for an Academic or a Visual/Performing Arts Scholarship, in either Middle School or High School.**

### **Academic Scholarship (Middle School and High School students only)**

- Grade-point average of 3.75, exceptional standardized test results, and/or outstanding academic record
- Evidence of academic excellence through awards / competitions
- Evidence of leadership roles and community service
- Displays qualities of character and maturity, which are supported by letters of recommendation
- The scholarship offer will be based on the strength of the student's profile

### **Visual / Performing Arts Scholarship (Middle School and High School students only)**

- Grade-point average of 3.25 or above and/or above-average standardized test results
- Demonstrated artistic excellence as evidenced by video performance(s), portfolio, awards, news releases, etc.
- Displays qualities of character and maturity, which are supported by letters of recommendation
- The scholarship offer will be based on the strength of the student's profile

### **Financial Need Scholarship**

*Predominantly for current students (a maximum of 5 scholarships will be offered annually)*

- Grade-point average of 3.25 or above and/or equivalent standardized test results
- Displays qualities of character and maturity
- This scholarship offer will be based on both the strength of the student's profile and the family's financial needs

To be considered for the Financial Need scholarship, the following information must be completed in full by both parents:

- Occupation
- Position
- Company name (if owner: company registration certificate – within last 3 months, company statements, bank confirmation issued from bank, form 51/50 tax reports)
- Salary certification (salary slips from the previous 6 months and bank book)
- Form 91/90 tax reports
- An explanation of any extenuating circumstances that add to financial hardship, as well as the percentage of tuition being sought as a scholarship
- These documents must be submitted to the SAO and will serve as the application

## APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- Fill out the online application form <https://rism.openapply.com/apply/> (**not required for current RIS students**)
- Submit three confidential letters of recommendation (2 teachers / 1 administrator)
- Submit an essay on future aspirations and goals (500 words maximum)
- Sit an entrance exam (**not required for current RIS students**)
- Attend a selection interview/audition
- Current RIS students: Submit the above documents in a sealed envelope on which you have written your name and grade to the School Advancement Office no later than March 27, 2020. Have it dated and signed by School Advancement personnel.

## Conditions

In all cases, a student may lose his/her scholarship for the subsequent academic year if the stated requirements are not maintained. Serious breaches of discipline will result in the immediate termination of financial aid offered through a scholarship for the remainder of the academic year.
