## Money Plant Golden

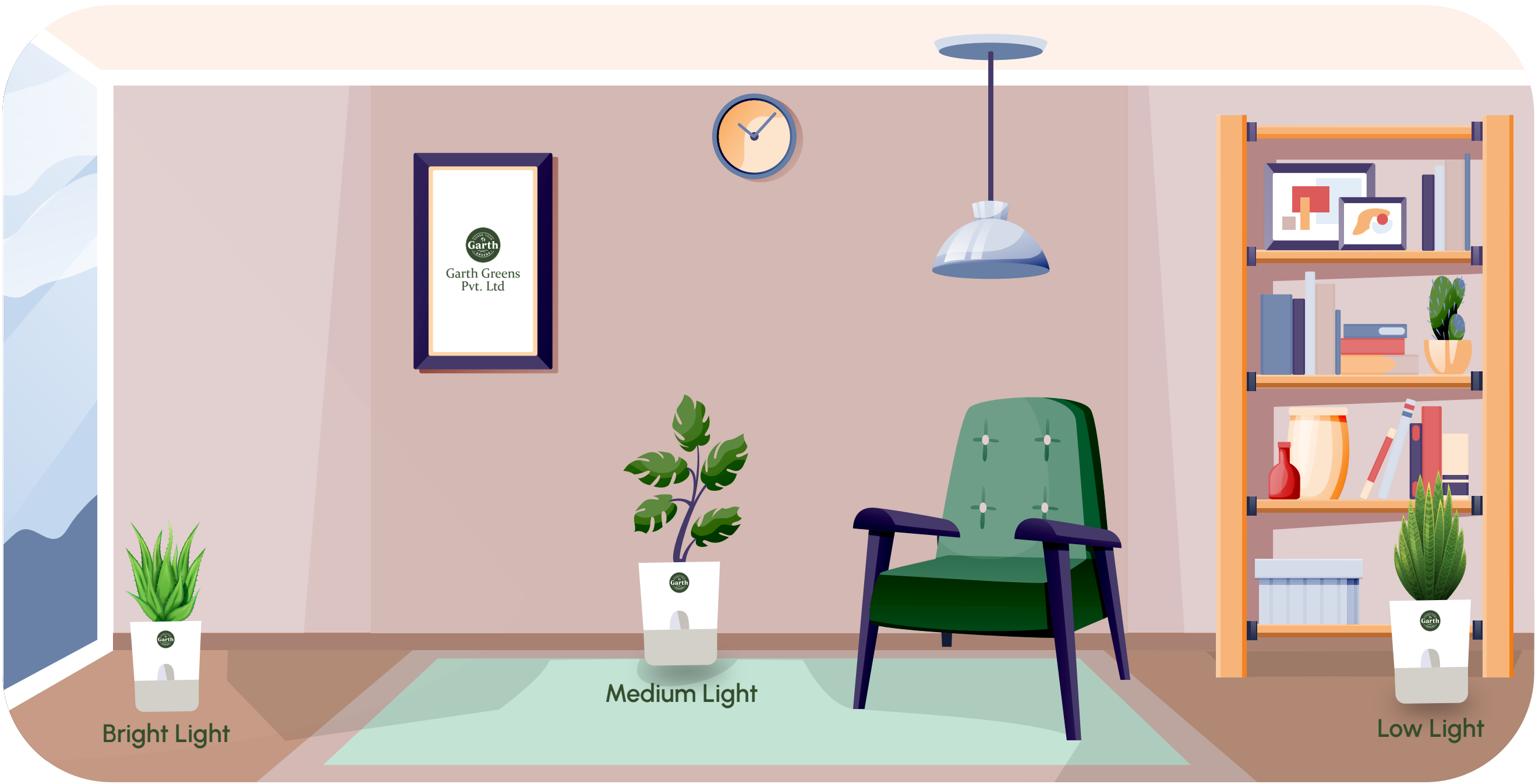
