

# Chinese Croton

The leaves of this rare beauty emerge a deep coppery pink and mature to a bronzy green and are broadly to narrowly edged, splashed with cream. The leaf undersides are a solid rich dark orange-pink color and the plant is often at its best where both sides of the foliage can be fully enjoyed.

semi-indoor

## Light

they can tolerate medium light conditions. we recommend placing them in partial shade with decent exposure to sunlight



## Watering

let the soil dry between waterings. during winter, reduce watering. too much water can kill the plant.
