

Syngonium Wendlandii

This arrowhead plant falls in the category of vines and climbers. It will also absorb odor from air, which makes it an excellent choice for places with little or no air-ventilation. As a houseplant, you can grow it as a hanging plant letting the vines dangle from the pot or provide support to let it grow as a climber.
