This is an evergreen perennial which is also classified as a woody vine. English ivy can act as a ground cover, spreading horizontally, and vertically. At home indoors or out, English ivy does well planted in containers or baskets where its trailing vines can hang down. Ivy needs protection from winter winds as well as the hot summer sun, so place appropriately.
