

Curtain Creeper

This is a curious member of the Sunflower family. It is a creeper which finds it difficult to climb without support. So, the slender stems climb up and then fall down beautifully over a wall or railing. The tender stems, all hanging down form a curtain, hence the name curtain creeper.

morning sunlight in the day is ideal for the plant to grow well. natural indirect bright light works best.



Watering

let the soil dry between waterings. during winter, reduce watering. too much water can kill the plant.
