SUBJECT NAME – PROFESSIONAL TRAINING

SUBJECT CODE – 1075101

- EMPHASIS:**
- To enable the students to get first hand practical training at Interior Designing and architectural firms
 - To gain practical training in the chosen field
 - To integrate the theoretical knowledge into practical situation.
 - To get placement for students after identifying their areas of interest those complement the curriculum / syllabi.
 - To become aware of current issues in the field of Interior Designing
 - To develop an ability in preparing a report.
 - To give opportunity to students to work independently though under supervision.
 - To raise the confidence level of the student.

- CONTENT:**
- As a part of the degree requirement, all candidates have to mandatorily undergo practical Training (full time) in the 7th semesters under a registered Architect/ Interior Designer (should have minimum 5 years of practical/ professional experience) for a period of 4 months -16 weeks in a semester (excluding viva-voce).
 - The student should involve herself/ himself in various aspects of work, in an office like working drawings, presentation drawings, quantity estimation, site supervision etc.
 - Student should understand professional practice methods of various interior designers, tender documents, production drawings for various works, site supervision etc. for various works.
 - They should also know the coordination of various agencies-clients, members of design team, consultants, contractors, craftsmen and construction supervisors.
 - Detailed instructions regarding the training, the frequency of reporting to the department etc will be issued at the end of sixth semester, which the student must strictly follow.
 - Internal Assessment for Practical Training will be evaluated by the Architect/ Interior Designer for Drawings/Detailing, Application of knowledge & skills and professional attitude under whom the candidate has been trained and by the training coordinator.

- PROJECTS:**
- Students will have to submit a detailed report with a set of drawings of at least two projects- in which he /she has worked during the 16 weeks of the practical training period.
 - The submission of the report will be evaluated at viva-voce by a jury consisting of one external, one internal and head of department/or nominee.
