Course Guidelines:

- All students have to enroll in a course outside classroom through online/offline mode or enroll for skill upgradation program during the semester
- Minimum duration of the course/program should be of 40 hours.

- All students have to submit certificate(s) of completion to appear in the internal as well as external viva
- Mere Enrolment in a training program/workshop will not be considered but the certificate of completion is required to submit.
- All students should enroll in the course/program which are relevant to their start-up.
- There must be clear mention of total number of hours on the certificate. If it is not mentioned then 5 hours per day will be considered.
- All students have to compile all the certificates and bind (Spiral). Students are also required to write the learning of each certificate in 500 words. The learning may be based on the content of the certification.
