

## Preparation of Faculty Mentors for Universal Human Values as per 2020-21 Approval Process Handbook

The NEP 2020 has given a clarion call for holistic value-based education to prepare our youth and develop our Nation, “Education is fundamental for achieving full human potential, developing an equitable and just society, and promoting national development”.

Each AICTE approved college is expected to prepare a minimum number of faculty to mentor students and to teach UHV. This is mentioned in the 2020-21 Approval Process Handbook also.

Suggestive selection criteria are provided below. They can be provided duty leave, by suitably adjusting their classes, to attend the 5-day Introductory UHV FDP ONLINE.

- Is presently teaching in an institution of professional education or at least has a teaching background.
- Is sincere, has a good rapport with the students, colleagues, staff as well as the management, alumni.
- Has interest in values, is making an effort to understand and live by values.
- Is involved in academic, social and community activities as a volunteer (through the institution and/or privately).
