Here is a brief snapshot of #SIH2019 process flow:

- College to appoint a Single Point of Contact (SPOC) who would go online and register himself / herself. College authority letter mandatory for SPOC registration! Latest AICTE Application no / AISHE id is required for registration
- Team leader would form a team of 6 including him/her (one female student compulsory) and register the team on the portal. College authority letter mandatory for team registration!
- All team members must be from the same college (having the same AICTE Application no / AISHE id).
- One team will have a unique team name only. As a team, they can submit solutions to multiple problem statements.
- College SPOC is expected to authenticate his/her college teams before they can select problem statements and upload idea solutions
- Once teams submit their ideas, College SPOC is expected to view the team's idea submission, ensure that it is in order and submit it to SIH team for evaluation purpose

Just like last year, we look forward to a fantastic response from your institute. Together let's make Smart India Hackathon 2019 a grand success.
