Objective: In Ayurveda, many indigenous plants have been claimed to posses diuretic effects, however these are not scientifically investigated till date. The present study was aimed to investigate the diuretic effects of aqueous (aqF) and ethanolic (EtF) crude extracts of Hemidesmosindicus R. Br. Roots using acute model of rats.

model of rats.

Methods: A single individual doses of AqF and EtF of H. Indicus root (200 mg/kg and 400 mg/kg, p.o, each), frusemide and hydrochorthiazide (25mg /kg, p.o, each) as reference diuretic drugs, were administered orally to dehydrated rats. Control groups rats were fed with normal saline 925 ml/ kg, p.o.). All rats were caged in a metabolic cages in a pairs and their urine output was monitored at 5 and 24 hour

Results: Both extracts significantly increased urine output in higer doses. Also onset of diuretic action was gradual (Within 5 Hr.), it lasted throughout the study period (upto 24 hours). Further the intensity of diuresis induced by AqE(400 mg/kg) in 5 hour is almost similar to furosemide and hydrochlorthiazide. AqE also increased in urinary Na and K level. However routine urin analysis showed non-significant alteration of ph and specific gravity by either dose of crude extracts.

Conclusion: These effects demonstrates possible diuretic actions of H.indicus roots extracts and supports its folklore use in various urinary ailments. Further studies need to be done to Characterize the active phytoconstituents from roots.
