Subject: Revised guideline for students, researchers, faculty members or start-ups (who are students or passed out in last five academic years) to avail financial assistance towards filing and prosecution of **Patent Application** on their respective invention through GTU IP Facilitator's/Registered Indian Patent Agents under Student Start-up Innovation Policy (SSIP).

All the Students, Researchers, Faculty Members, Start-ups and Registered Indian Patent Agents.

In our endeavour to inculcate culture of innovation amongst the students, researchers, faculty member or start-ups (who are students or passed out in last five academic years) and to provide a conducive environment for optimum harnessing of their creative pursuit, **The Education Department, Government of Gujarat** had issued **Student Start-up and Innovation Policy (SSIP) 2017-2021**, vide G.R. No. PRC/2016/IPIES/DS/S/710197, dated: 11/01/2017.

In the recent development the Government has revised said IPR guideline under SSIP policy vide no. GKS/SSIP/2021-22/IPR Guideline/31, dated: 08/06/2021 for extending support for End-to-End IP facilitation to facilitate young innovators and entrepreneurs in protecting their Intellectual Property Rights, wherein the financial assistance has been extended from filing to prosecution of the respective IPR. In view of the aforesaid, GTU Innovation Council (GIC) under Gujarat Technological University which is committed to promote and protect IPR under the visionary leadership of Prof. Dr. Navin Sheth, the Vice Chancellor of GTU, revise

the previous IPR guideline of GTU vide no. GTU/GIC/IPR/2018/90/7551, dated 09/10/2018 and realize said revised IPR guideline under SSIP Policy in the same.

In view of the above, the financial assistance provided under the revised IPR guideline under SSIP Policy will be disbursed by GTU according to the Annexure-1 at different stages of Filing and Prosecution of Patent applications. The revised scheme guideline for End-to End facilitation under SSIP Policy is made effective from 01/10/2021 by GTU, and reimbursement will only be done towards the bills/invoices generated and dated after said date. Furthermore, those Patent applications which were filed by beneficiaries in past by availing assistance under SSIP Policy through GTU, are also entitled to claim assistance under revised guideline. The present guideline of GTU shall be read in conjunction with the previous guideline of GTU vide no. GTU/GIC/IPR/2018/90/7551, dated 09/10/2018.

In view of the aforesaid, GTU is extending functions and duties of the empanelled Facilitators to realize the objective of End-to-End IP facilitation under SSIP Policy to the beneficiaries stated previously in the guideline of GTU vide no. GTU/GIC/IPR/2018/90/7551, dated 09/10/2018 and nowhere the revised guideline limiting the functions and duties of the empanelled Facilitators.

The procedural requirements and process flow for the disbursement of the financial assistance shall be the same as stated in the previous IPR guideline of GTU vide no. GTU/GIC/IPR/2018/90/7551, dated 09/10/2018.

For the effective realization of the SSIP Policy, GTU-GIC reserves the right to recommend IP Facilitator to the beneficiary after thorough consultation with the University screening committee based on the educational qualification of the IP Facilitator and experience in the concerned technical field. The aforesaid clause shall supersede in case of any conflict with the previous guideline of GTU vide no. GTU/GIC/IPR/2018/90/7551, dated 09/10/2018.

Further, to encourage young innovators and entrepreneurs, GTU-GIC is herewith framing two way approaches to reach GTU-GIC with their respective innovative subject matter.

I. Through Workshop: Those students, innovators and entrepreneurs who are not aware with IPR subject matter shall first attend the IPR workshop organized by GTU-GIC, wherein they will familiarize themselves with the concept of IPR that will further help them to identify IP or the novel and inventive aspects in their project. Thereafter, their concerned project will be first assessed by the University IP Screening Committee and on approval, the facilitation will be done under revised SSIP guideline.

II. Walk-in:

- i. Those students, innovators and entrepreneurs who already have credible prior-art search report wherein the report suggests that the subject matter of the project is novel and inventive. They can directly approach GTU-GIC where University IP Screening Committee will assess the project and on approval, the facilitation will be done under revised SSIP guideline.
- ii. In an exceptional circumstance where the student, innovator or entrepreneur has involuntarily disclosed his/her project in the public domain which is intended to be protected under IPR regime, they can directly approach GTU-GIC, where University IP Screening Committee will assess the project and on approval, the facilitation will be done under revised SSIP guideline.

Note:

- a. The procedural requirements and the process flow for the assessment of project shall be the same as stated in the previous IPR guideline of GTU vide no. GTU/GIC/IPR/2018/90/7551, dated 09/10/2018.
- b. The disbursement of financial assistance at different stages of Filing and Prosecution of Patent applications shall be done according to Annexure-1.
- c. The mechanism, notes, terms and conditions, rules, norms, procedural aspects etc. for beneficiaries and facilitators shall be the same as stated in the previous IPR guideline of GTU vide no. GTU/GIC/IPR/2018/90/7551, dated 09/10/2018, unless

otherwise explicitly stated herein.

Annexure-1

Extended support for End to End IP facilitation:

Under the SSIP Policy innovators and start-ups are extended support of Average INR 25000 for domestic IP filing which covers charges of prior art search, patent drafting and patent filing at Indian Patent Office including government fees. To ensure that the respective filed IPs also reach to next level, further financial Support of average 25000 INR to be extended to these teams for Patent office action (Patent Prosecutions) like Report to Pre-Grant opposition, Reply to FER (First Examination Report), SER (Second Examination Report), Attend the hearing and allied efforts. These will improve our patent filing to grant ratio.

In addition to above mentioned once patent is filed in India and if applicant find scope of invention in international market, may wish to file Convention/PCT Patent application then further financial support of Up-to 1,00,000 INR or 80% of total applicable charges (Patent Office charges+ Professional charges), whichever is less will be reimbursed to empaneled IP Facilitator.

Below are the details of charges to be paid to IP facilitators. However, these charges are applicable for one year and subjected to revision by SSIP.
