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Circular:

Introduction of Mathematics, Chemistry and Physics as supplementary Subjects for VI Sem. in Diploma of Architectural Assistantship (50) and Diploma in Architecture (62).

National Aptitude Test in Architecture has given the following as its eligibility for students who want to appear for NATA- 19 examination, mandatory for admission in B. Arch. Course.

‘Passed 10+2 scheme of examination with 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics and also 50% marks in aggregate at 10+2 level examination; (those appearing the 10+2 exam with PCM subjects in the current year may also provisionally appear in the exam, however, their result in NATA-2019 will be declared valid subject to fulfilling the above criteria).’

Council of Architecture is putting its efforts to get this eligibility criteria changed to the one that was in last year, so that the students pursuing Diploma Architecture (DA) and Diploma Architecture Assistantship (DAA) also become eligible. For this, the students of Diploma Architecture and Diploma Architecture Assistantship studying in 6th semester will have to study the supplementary subjects mentioned in the table below over and above the subjects which are part of the programme of 6th Sem.

Subject Code	Subject Name
C300001	BASIC MATHEMATICS
C300011	BASIC CHEMISTRY
C300005	BASIC PHYSICS

The syllabus will remain the same that is taught in the 1st sem. of diploma engineering with subject code 3300001, 3300011 and 3300005 respectively. Teaching Scheme is available on GTU website with the following link of detailed syllabus: <https://www.gtu.ac.in/syllabus/D.arch.htm>

Diploma Section will upload the examination forms in the month of March to appear in Summer 2019 examination for the students who passed out in last 3 years (i.e. Summer 2016 to winter 2018) along with the students who are studying in sem-6 currently. If students other than these want to appear in the exam, exam form will be generated on the request received from the institute.

Examination of these subjects (C300001, C300011, C300005) will arrange parallel with exam of Diploma Sem-1, 2 Summer 2019 to have unique paper for both the courses. The exam pattern for these three subjects will be of MCQ types. The institute will have to implement the new structure of ‘Training Semester’ i.e. Sixth Semester of DA/DAA. without affecting the training period of the students.

Those diploma students who wants to pursue Bachelor degree in Architecture will have to study the supplementary subjects mentioned in the above table over and above the subjects which are part of the programme of 6th semester and diploma colleges are instructed to make arrangements for teaching these subjects.
