About Sankul Day

The 1st Industrial ‘Shodh Yatra’ (a research journey) by GTU was initiated by 31 students and 4 faculties of VGEC under GTU at GIDC industrial estate, Naroda on 14th Feb 2011. By June 2011, more than 50,000 students replicated it all over Gujarat. Within 6 months of the effort, GTU won the Best Jury Award in the category of Best Interface between Academia – Industry at the World Education Summit 2011. To mark the success, GTU declared 14th Feb as GTU Innovation Sankul Day. GTU has set up 25 GTU Innovation Sankuls. Each Sankul provides a platform for Colleges and industries in a geographic region to work together.

Pedagogical Innovation Awards

GTU Innovation Council had declared the “Pedagogical Innovation Awards” to recognize and appreciate the excellent work done by students, faculty members, Principals/ Directors and other stakeholders in GTU. The 1st Pedagogical Innovation Awards were presented on the 2nd Sankul Day on 14th February 2013.

This year on the 5th Sankul Day, GTU is organizing the 3rd Pedagogical Innovation Award function at Paryavaran Mandir. Nominations from Dean, Principal/Director, Sankul Co-Chair (industry), Sankul Co-Chair (academic), HOD, Director of a Sankul, faculties and other education stakeholders were invited for Pedagogical Innovation Award.

Introducing “Innovative Students’ Co-Creation Awards for Leadership and Excellence “ (i-SCALE) Awards

This year GTU will also present “Innovative Students’ Co-Creation Awards for Leadership and Excellence “(i-SCALE) Awards. I-SCALE have been established to scout, recognize and award student-led initiatives in the fields of innovation, technology development, pedagogy, leadership, entrepreneurship and similar other endeavours. GTU has invited nominations across the colleges of engineering, management, pharmacy, diploma, MCA and others. Criteria for judgement will be the impact of the initiative, persistent and extraordinary efforts and sustainable approach.

Innovate to Impact awards: (i2i)

This year also GTU will also present "i2i (Innovate to Impact)" Award to recognise innovative projects of students across GTU affiliated colleges in Engineering, Polytechnic, Pharmacy, MCA, MBA and others. Students of Diploma, Degree, Masters and PhD program can nominate their innovations for this coveted award which will be given away on 14th February 2019 during GTU Innovation Sankul day. Student’s Projects which address an important social, technological problem

faced by masses or disadvantaged people/sectors/spaces or micro and small enterprises or have the potential to impact a pressing national need may nominate themselves.

Student Startup Award:

This is 1st time GTU will present The Student Startup Awards are for celebrating and recognising the achievements of our students and recent graduates exploring the world of start-up. Any student or recent graduate (last 5 years alumni) can nominate his venture/startup in this category.

Early Stage Student Start-up : (0 to 3 years of operation) :

This category includes

- i. Student Start-up which is in pre incubation stage or similar having been started by one or more co-founders in his/her college days or having been started by an alumni of any institute affiliated with GTU within 2 years of passing out from any academic program.
- ii. This also includes any other start-up which is incubated or otherwise but it is between 0-3 years of its operation since its incorporation.

Growth stage Student Start-up: (3-5 year of operation) :

This category includes

Student Entrepreneurs/Startups of any institute affiliated with GTU who are currently being incubated or otherwise which are into 3-5 years of their operation with substantial value creation/impact/ revenue/ customer base can submit their proposal under this category.

The team/Project should be a registered entity as per start-up India mandate.
