Competition Kick-Off Webinar — Q&A / FAQ

A. Eligibility — Who can participate?

Q. Are 2026 graduates / passouts eligible to participate?

Answer: NO

Q. Are first-year students eligible?

Answer: NO

Q. Are second-year / pre-final-year students eligible? (e.g. entering 3rd year in July)

Answer: Second year – NO, Pre-Final year or students who have entered their 3rd year in July - YES

Q. Which batches qualify for internship vs PPI opportunities (2026 / 2027 / 2028)?

Answer: Both Batch 2027 and 2028. Batch 2026 is not eligible.

Q. Is this open only to engineering students, or to all streams?

Answer: Only engineering students, no other courses are eligible.

Q. Are MCA students eligible?

Answer: NO

Q. Are M.Tech / M.Sc / Master's students eligible? (incl. M.Tech Computer Engineering)

Answer: NO. However, Dual degree integrated students from engineering programs are eligible (pre-final & final year only).

Q. Are BCA students eligible?

Answer: NO

Q. Is a B.Sc (e.g. from an IIT) eligible, or only engineering (B.Tech) degrees?

Answer: B.Sc NOT ELIGIBLE, B.Tech Eligible (Final & Pre-Final year only)

Q. Are diploma holders / recent diploma passouts eligible?

Answer: If highest degree is diploma, then NOT ELIGIBLE.

Q. Are students pursuing an AI-DS minor (with a different core branch) eligible?

Answer: YES, the contest is open to all specializations in engineering programs.

Q. Are integrated M.Sc programs eligible?

Answer: YES (provided the UG degree under the integrated program is BE or BTech)

Q. Can students with a current backlog / KT in a subject apply?

Answer: YES

Q. Is there any 10th / 12th / UG percentage eligibility requirement?

Answer: NO, but those scores may be considered for profile shortlisting.

Q. Can male students participate, or is this a women-only event?

Answer: Women-only event

Q. Are students from autonomous / tier-2 / tier-3 colleges considered?

Answer: YES, the competition is OPEN to all engineering colleges PAN India.

Q. International students studying in India: the registration form requires Aadhaar — is there an alternative (e.g. PAN card) for those without one?

Answer: NO, only Aadhar card is applicable

B. Team Formation

Q. Can we participate solo / individually?

Answer: NO, it is a team-based contest (Minimum 2 members, maximum 3)

Q. Can team members be from different colleges (cross-college teams)?

Answer: NO, team members should be from the SAME college.

Q. Can a team include members from different academic years?

Answer: YES

Q. I don't have a team / can't find teammates from my college — what should I do?

Answer: Without a team, you will not be considered for further shortlisting. Team formation is mandatory.

Q. Can team members be changed after registration is complete?

Answer: NO

Q. How do we register as a team — does each member register separately, or does one person register everyone?

Answer: Complete your own registration first; you will then get the option to add team members.

Q. How does a teammate accept the invitation? Should she complete her own registration first, or join via the invite link?

Answer: First, the team lead should complete the registration, post which the team lead can send out invites to the team members of choice.

Q. A teammate registered individually by mistake instead of via the team invite — how do we fix this?

C. Registration Process & Technical Issues

Q. Where is the registration link / form?

Q. What is the registration deadline? (e.g. is it 1 PM on 1 July?)

Answer: YES

Q. Why does the form ask for the college placement officer's number and email? Is it mandatory?

Answer: While this field is not mandatory, it is encouraged to share the placement team details so that Myntra team can reach out to them to share updates if your team progresses through the competition.

Q. I can't upload the live picture during registration — what should I do?

Answer: Please reach out to the support team - campusconnect@mycareernet.co

Q. The 'Register Now' button is unresponsive — how do I proceed?

Answer: Please reach out to the support team - campusconnect@mycareernet.co

Q. I'm unable to add my teammate's details — the form only asks for one person's details. How do I add the rest?

Answer: Please reach out to the support team - campusconnect@mycareernet.co

Q. Can I re-register / submit a fresh application with a better resume (possibly from a different email)? Will duplicate registrations be disqualified?

Answer: Once registered, you cannot re-register.

Q. Can I edit my application after submitting it?

Answer: Please reach out to the support team - campusconnect@mycareernet.co

Q. I completed registration (and my teammates accepted), but I received an 'incomplete application' / 'register again' email — do I need to register again?

Answer: Please reach out to the support team - campusconnect@mycareernet.co

Q. Should we register using a college email or a personal email? Does it affect selection?

Answer: We encourage you to register using your college email address, but it does not affect your selection.

Q. What is the official support email / contact?

Answer: Please reach out to the support team - campusconnect@mycareernet.co

D. Shortlisting Criteria for the Online Assessment (OA)

Q. Is there a shortlisting / screening round BEFORE the online assessment, or is the OA the first round?

Answer: There will be a shortlisting before the Online Assessment Test. Only shortlisted candidates will be allowed to attend the test.

Q. What exactly is meant by 'profile' and 'past credentials' in the shortlisting context?

Answer: Academic scores, past background

Q. Is a LinkedIn / GitHub profile required or considered for shortlisting?

Answer: It is preferred to be added to your resume.

Q. Is there any college-based preference (e.g. IITs / NITs / IIITs over private colleges)?

Answer: NO

Q. Last year, candidates from non-circuit branches colleges were reportedly not shortlisted — will that change this year?

Answer: This year, specialization is not a constraint.

Q. When and where will shortlisted candidates/teams be notified?

Answer: A day or two prior to the test - through formal communication on registered email ID.

Q. I entered my CGPA slightly wrong (e.g. 8 instead of 8.5) — does it matter / can I correct it?

E. Online Assessment — Format, Prep & Logistics

Q. What is the OA pattern? (Coding + MCQs? DSA only?)

Answer: MCQ + Coding

Q. Is aptitude part of the OA, or only DSA and CS fundamentals?

Answer: Core CS fundamentals

Q. Which programming languages are allowed? (Is Python available? C++ version? Java-specific MCQs?)

Answer: Multiple languages allowed

Q. What is the duration of the OA (how many hours)?

Answer: 70 minutes

Q. What is the OA window / timing? Can the 9 AM–3 PM window be extended for those travelling?

Answer: Shortlisted participants will be allowed to choose a specific slot between 9 AM to 3 PM, based on their convenience. The participants have to attempt the test accordingly. No scope of extension.

Q. Does the OA prioritise accuracy or speed/time taken? Is time a scoring parameter?

Answer: In the OA, accuracy is prioritised. However, if two students have scored the same, time taken to complete the test will be considered.

Q. Is there an individual cutoff, a team cutoff, or both?

Answer: Individual as well as team cut-off.

Q. If some team members clear the OA but one does not, is the whole team disqualified?

Answer: YES, the whole team gets disqualified.

Q. Is there any additional technical round beyond the coding + MCQ OA?

Answer: Only one round of Online Assessment Test.

Q. Where / how do we get the OA link, and when?

Answer: The link to take the Online Assessment Test will be shared with the shortlisted candidates only, post the shortlist is announced.

Q. Is the assessment online or offline?

Answer: ONLINE

Q. How can we best prepare / where should we start? Any recommended resources?

Answer:

What to Expect: Core Technical Aptitude & Problem Solving, Emerging Technologies and Programming Questions.

Recommended Preparation Resources: GeeksforGeeks, InterviewBit flashcards, W3Schools quiz.

Format Focus: Prioritise conceptual flashcards, Top 100 Liked Medium Leetcode questions/ InterviewBit interview

Key Areas: Ensure a balanced knowledge of core software engineering concepts.

F. Themes, Problem Statements & Submission

Q. Can you walk through / re-display the themes?

Answer: The themes are outlined in detail in the competition page, please go through the same carefully.

Q. Will the webinar slide deck / themes document be shared afterwards?

Answer: Webinar recording will be available on the competition page, you may refer to the same for the slides.

Q. Do we have to address all the three themes, or just one?

Answer: ONE

Q. Can we combine two (or more) themes into a single problem statement?

Answer: You may, but it is encouraged to pick ONE single problem statement (even if it covers multiple themes) to make the execution process easier for your team.

Q. Do you provide the problem statements, or do we define our own within the given themes?

Answer: Problem statements should be defined by the team. Myntra will not provide the same.

Q. Can we choose our own problem statement?

Answer: Teams need to choose their own problem statement under one of the three given themes for this year.

Q. Can teams propose solutions beyond the given problem statements if they address the same challenge?

Answer: YES, only idea starters have been shared not problem statements. Teams need to choose and define their own problem statement from one of the given themes.

Q. If we have multiple ideas, can we submit more than one?

Answer: Ideally, work on one idea to make the execution easier. You may explore more, if you wish to. However, shortlisted teams will be evaluated for their core problem statement/idea.

Q. Do we have to build a clone of the Myntra app based on the theme?

Answer: Innovation/Idea should be relevant to Myntra business. Cloning myntra app is not mandatory.

Q. Can we use AI tools / GenAI in our workflow and prototype development? (Is 'vibe coding' acceptable?)

Answer: YES. Additionally, the team should be aware of tech choices and high level architecture and should explain it well.

Q. What kind of solution are you looking for? Is a working prototype required? Can we use synthetic data? How much weight is on AI?

Answer: Factors it will be measured on are clarity of problem statement picked up (as per defined themes), originality, feasibility, impact and clarity of tech design and choices. A working prototype is needed. Exact weight on AI data is not defined but if you can use GenAI powers to unlock your business features, it will be a feather in the cap. Sample data can be used.

Q. Is innovation weighted more heavily than technical complexity? Any preference for AI-native vs traditional approaches?

Answer: Innovation and tech complexity together.

Q. What exactly must be submitted on 24 July? (Prototype + presentation — please clarify the timeline.)

Answer: The deck outlining your problem statement, work scope and solutions as per the format given by Myntra has to be submitted. In the deck, a screen recording of the prototype needs to be submitted. But during the virtual presentation, the live demo of the prototype is mandatory.

Q. What differentiates top-performing / winning teams from average submissions? What common gaps hold good ideas back?

Answer: Clarity of problem statement picked up (as per defined themes), originality, feasibility, impact on myntra business, relevance to myntra, clarity of tech design and choices.

G. Rewards, Certificates, PPI & Internship

Q. What is the prize / reward structure? How is the ₹3 lakh prize money distributed?

Answer: Prize reward structure is explained in the competition page, please go through the same for more details.

Q. What do the top 100 shortlisted teams receive? What do the top 6 finalist teams receive?

Answer: All teams qualified in Top 100 will receive digital participation certificates. The rewards for the Top 6 team has been explained in the competition page, please go through the same for more details.

Q. Are PPIs (Pre-Placement Interviews) only for finalists, or can they be earned via OA/overall performance and profile?

Answer: Only for FINALISTS

Q. PPI is for which role — SDE, Business Analyst, or something else?

Answer: Currently SDE, but other roles can also be explored based on role availability.

Q. Are PPIs for full-time roles (FTE) or for internships?

Answer: Internships only. However, internships may convert into FTE roles based on performance based PPO.

Q. What is the internship duration and timeline?

Answer: 6 months, tentatively from Jan to June

Q. Are the internships paid? What is the stipend / fresher compensation?

Answer: Yes, stipend will depend on the role.

Q. For pre-final-year/third year finalists: is the PPI now, or are they called for interviews next year without re-participating?

Answer: For finalists from pre-final or third year (Batch 2028), they will be considered for the next hiring cycle and the PPI will happen later (not on 13th Aug)

Q. Will 2028-batch students get internship opportunities through this?

Answer: Yes, provided they are a finalist and clear the Pre-Placement interview (PPI) process.

Q. Is there a background verification step in the process?

Answer: YES

H. Webinar Logistics & General

Q. Will this webinar be recorded, and where will the recording be available?

Answer: YES it was recorded, it will be uploaded in the competition site and will also be shared over email to all registered participants.

Q. Is attending the webinar mandatory to be eligible for the next round?

Answer: NO
