


Harmonics Definition

This graphic shows the first five commonly used harmonics. The diamond shaped notes mark the places where you touch the string lightly to create the sub-division.

The regular notes show the actual pitch that sounds when you play these harmonics.



Here are the five rules that make playing harmonics reliable:

- Play close to the bridge
- Lots of bow speed
- Lots of bow pressure
- Tilt your bow
- No martelé
