Topic: Ethnic Musical Instruments

There are kinds of old musical instruments in the country. Our ancestors had used it for making music. Some of them are the following.

Ethnical Stringed Musical Instruments:

1. KUDYAPI (Maranao-Mindanao)
 - Wooden lute with 4-6 feet long
2. BUKTOT (Visayas)
 - Four stringed guitar-like instruments made from coconut husk.

Ethnic Wind Musical Instruments

1. TONGALI (Northern Areas of the country)
 - With 3-4 holes and one hole at the back where air is forced through the nostrils.
2. . KUBING (Mindanao)
 - A jaw harp made of bamboo

Other ethnical musical instruments.

1. Kulintang
2. Gambal
3. Dabakan
4. Luntang
5. Kulintang A Tiniok
6. Babandil
