Research Abstract

- gives the summary of your research report
- researchers would normally not read the entire article before judging whether or not the paper contains relevant information
- researchers will have a glimpse of the title first as it probably bears some key words
- its goal is to encourage readers to take a moment to go over and read the whole document
- sentences must be constructed in a straightforward manner
- it reflects you, as author, are proud and certain of your results
- is a one –paragraph section comprising no more than 10 sentences, about 100 to 500 words and comes after the title and the author’s name and affiliation
- its lead sentence should express why the study was undertaken and what was the study offers the readers in relation to previous studies
- a brief description of the methodology is to be included as well as significant findings
