SPREADING CHRISTMAS CHEER TO 7,000 UNDERPRIVILEGED PEOPLE WITH GIFTS WORTH ABOUT \$470,000

New Creation Church, West Coast GRC and Pioneer GROs join hands to kick off Gift Of Love 2018 to build a more compassionate community.

Singapore, 1 December 2018: This Christmas season, New Creation Church will be helping some 7,000 underprivileged people with about \$470,000 in practical gifts through its Gift Of Love 2018 initiative. It kicks off today with the Christmas Gift Of Love lunch party, one of three Christmas Gift Of Love events that also include a dinner party this evening and another event on 8 December 2018.

At the Christmas Gift Of Love lunch party held at Boon Lay Community Centre today, it was a familiar yet heartwarming sight as underprivileged families tucked into lunch with a choice of Chinese, vegetarian or halal food, enjoyed performances of community and national songs, sung popular Christmas carols, and received both \$100 in supermarket vouchers and \$100 worth of essentials such as detergent and canned goods in a gift trolley.

Co-organised by New Creation Church, West Coast GRC and Pioneer Constituency Grassroots Organisations (GROs) to benefit about 300 people in the district and their families, the lunch party also featured a specially planned multicultural programme by the church's creative team, featuring items like an energetic dance, *Singai Naadu*, *Ku Mohon*, 小人物的心声, We Are Singapore, Christmas carols and a rendition of the popular National Day song, Home.

Mr S Iswaran, Minister for Communications and Information, and Adviser to West Coast GRC GROs, said, "The year end is a time for celebration with family and friends, but also a time for giving. I am very glad that New Creation Church, West Coast Group Representation









Constituency and Pioneer Constituency Grassroots Organisations, are joining hands to reach out and help those in need in our community, and to celebrate as one regardless of background or beliefs."

New Creation Church's council member, Deacon Matthew Kang, said, "Christmas is a season of giving and New Creation Church is so glad to be able to show God's love to 300 individuals of West Coast GRC and Pioneer Constituency and their families with supermarket vouchers and a gift trolley filled with daily essentials, as well as help about 7,000 people all over Singapore with practical gifts worth about \$470,000."

Besides the lunch party, a Christmas Gift Of Love dinner co-organised by New Creation Church and Ci Yuan Community Club Management Committee, and graced by guest of honour Mr Darryl David, Adviser to Ang Mo Kio GRC GROs, will be held this evening to help some 150 people of Ang Mo Kio GRC and their families with \$15,000 worth of supermarket vouchers.

And on Saturday, 8 December 2018, the church will partner Marsiling-Yew Tee GRC GROs, to distribute gift trolleys filled with daily essentials worth over \$60,000 to 900 families in the constituency. Mr Lawrence Wong, Minister for National Development and Adviser to Marsiling-Yew Tee GRC GROs will be present at the event where Mr Zaqy Mohamad, Minister of State for National Development and Manpower and Adviser to Chua Chu Kang GRC GROs will join the event.

New Creation Church has been organising the Christmas Gift Of Love events since 2014 as part of its Gift Of Love initiative to extend practical help and love to the less privileged in society during the Christmas season.

Including 2018, the church has helped over 67,500 people in Singapore and the region through its Gift Of Love initiative by giving approximately \$2 million in supermarket vouchers and gift packs. Throughout the year, the church also regularly helps underprivileged families, people with special needs and elderly, as well as foreign workers in Singapore. This year, the church has helped more than 11,400 people through some 150 programmes in Singapore, as well as another 13,200 people in the region.
