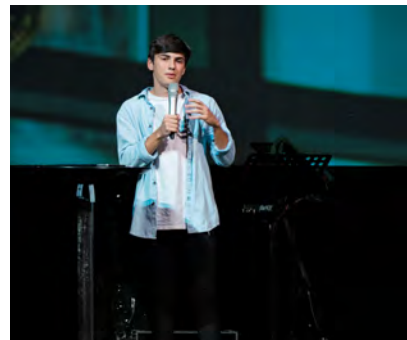

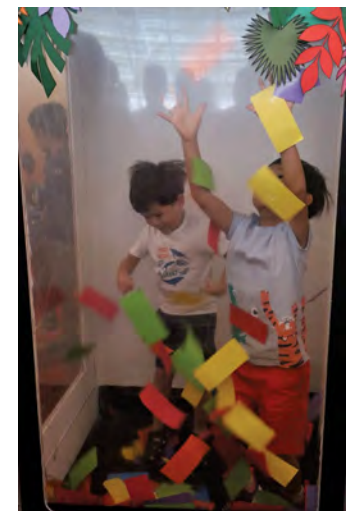


CHILDREN'S DAY

JESUS YOUR
JUBILEE!





Jesus is our ever-present Jubilee.

Jesus was reading the passage about the ministry of the Messiah from Isaiah 61:1–2, where the Hebrew word for “liberty” was the same one used in Leviticus 25:10 to describe the Jubilee year. And then He said to those gathered there, “*Today this Scripture is fulfilled in your hearing*” (Luke 4:21b).

With that startling pronouncement, Jesus was declaring that *He* is our ever-present Jubilee. We don’t have to wait 50 years for a fresh start in life or to be set free from any fear, bad habit, debt or addiction. We can experience liberty from any bondage once we’ve accepted Jesus as our beautiful Lord and Saviour, because He is the anointed one with divine power to set captives free!

Beloved, God wants us to believe the Jubilee blessings we have been trusting Him for are going to manifest. That fresh start, that freedom, that deliverance...believe you *will* see it soon!

OWN THE JUBILEE BLESSINGS FOR YOUR LIFE

Let’s take a closer look at what the Bible says about the Jubilee blessings.

In Leviticus 25:10, it says that “*each of you shall return to his possession.*” So if you have lost a possession, be it your health or peace of mind, take heart. God is setting in motion His wonderful, incomparable restoration in your life. You’ll have your health back. Your mind will be at ease once more. In fact, when the Lord restores, He always makes it better than before!

According to this verse, Jubilee is a time when liberty is proclaimed. So not only will your possessions freely return to you, but you can

Jubilee!

Look it up in the dictionary and you’ll see that it’s a season of celebration, the proclamation of a significant event, a time of rejoicing in honour of something special.

It’s a time likely awaited with mounting excitement and marked by great festivities and joy. For the Israelites in Old Testament times, Jubilee, which occurred once every fifty years, meant debts would be cancelled, land that had been lost would be returned, and slaves would be freed to return to their families:

And you shall consecrate the fiftieth year, and proclaim liberty throughout all the land to all its inhabitants. It shall be a Jubilee for you; and each of you shall return to his possession, and each of you shall return to his family.
(Leviticus 25:10)

If you were back in ancient Israel as the people ushered in the year of Jubilee, you would almost hear the people breathe a deep sigh of relief,

“*Finally!*” at its arrival. It probably felt like a huge reset button was being pressed in their lives, giving them a fresh start no matter what loss had happened, what mistakes had been made, and where they were at in life.

Today, my friend, if like the biblical Jews anticipating Jubilee you have been trusting God for freedom from something that has held you captive or if you’ve been praying for a return of lost possessions, debt cancellation, or restoration of family relationships, I want you to know that this biblical Jubilee can be your reality. This is God’s word for us!

WHY LIBERTY CAN BE YOURS

In Luke 4, we see our Lord Jesus walking into a synagogue and declaring that the Spirit of the Lord was upon Him “*to heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives...to set at liberty those who are oppressed; to proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord*” (Luke 4:18–19, emphasis mine).

also be free of every bondage — physical, mental, emotional, and financial. If you've been in some sort of bondage because of bad decisions and mistakes you have made, receive God's promise and blessings of Jubilee and see yourself, by His grace, free of the bondage. That is God's promise to you!

In addition, God has His eye on restoring family relationships. Leviticus 25:10 says, *"each of you shall return to his family."* Has your teenage son left home or has your teenage daughter been in a cold war with you for the longest time? Maybe your marriage has hit its lowest point ever. Well, the Lord is bringing restoration to all these broken relationships! Let Him lovingly restore family relationships and put your family back together, making it whole in every way.

Would you like to know what else Jubilee holds for you? If you read Luke 4:18–19, Jubilee ushers in *"the acceptable year of the Lord."* The word *acceptable* here comes from the Greek word *dektos*, which according to Thayer's Greek Lexicon refers to "that most blessed time when salvation and the free favours of God profusely abound." Where do you need to see God's free favours profusely abound?

Let Him lovingly restore family relationships and put your family back together.

In your career? Your family life or ministry? I am believing with you that in that very area, you are going to experience an abundance of God's free favours — so that He can show His goodness and grace through your life!

FROM JOBLESS AND DEPRESSED TO HAVING PEACE AND FINANCIAL STABILITY

But Pastor Prince, it doesn't feel like any of the above is happening for me. In fact, it feels like troubles are closing in on me from all sides. Things are bad and I can't see any way out.

My friend, let me share Becky's testimony with you. I pray it will put faith in your heart to believe that while your challenges may be pressing in on you, God can still unleash His Jubilee blessings on you when you look to Him. Here is her story:

A few months ago, I made bad decisions that left me jobless and in serious debt. I became depressed and even thought about ending my life. Despite everything, I felt the Lord's love deep within my heart and knew He would never forsake me. I cried out to Him for help every day.



When my best friend introduced me to Pastor Prince's ministry, the Lord led me to listen to his teachings. I would watch his sermons on YouTube daily and declare the Lord's divine exchange at the cross for me. I confessed that He had taken away my sins, depression, sickness, and death, and had given me His love, forgiveness, life, health, peace, righteousness, and wholeness.

Today, I have a good job and my financial situation has improved. Most importantly, the depression is completely gone. I no longer have suicidal thoughts and there is so much peace within me now.

Thank You, Jesus, for Your amazing grace, favour, love, and goodness. I am so grateful for the true gospel that sets people free!

Hallelujah! When things looked like they couldn't be any bleaker, the Lord took Becky from being jobless, deep in debt, depressed and suicidal to having a good job, a means of financial stability, and a heart full of peace.

It's as if the Lord had hit the reset button for her life, giving her a fresh start and freeing her from her bondages. My friend, this is what Jubilee is about. And what the Lord did for Becky, He can and wants to do for you too!

REST — THE BATTLE IS THE LORD'S

Our Lord Jesus has given us three practical keys to help us experience Jubilee. The first one is rest,

exemplified by how Becky rested in the truth that the Lord loved her and would never forsake her. The Bible tells us that because of His love for us, He never forsakes us but is with us to overcome everything we're afraid of (ref.: Hebrews 13:5-6). Becky just rested in this truth and saw the Lord's faithfulness to His Word.

Let's look closer at what God's Word says about rest with regards to the Jubilee: "You shall neither sow nor reap" (Leviticus 25:11). His people were not to work their lands. What does this mean for us today? Are we to quit our jobs or become lazy and irresponsible? No, what the Lord is saying here is that we are to quit being worried and anxious about the challenges we are facing. Instead, He wants us to entrust our cares to Him and rest in the truth that He who never fails is working on them. The battle is the Lord's!



Now, the enemy will tell you, "How can you not worry about your rebellious teenager, your failing career, or that mountain of debt?" Beloved, the reason you can rest even though you may be surrounded by troubles today is this: The One who loves you beyond measure is watching over you and taking care of all your needs and challenges.

When worrisome thoughts start to creep into your mind, turn to the Lord and say, "Lord Jesus, I know You love me. You are bigger and greater than any challenge I'm facing. Your hands are bigger than mine so I'm giving You this battle. You will lead me to victory as I simply rest in Your love for me and lean on Your grace."

HEAR YOUR WAY TO JUBILEE

God knows that it's often difficult for us to rest and give Him our battles, as our human inclination is

to worry and take on the battles ourselves. That is why He has given us the next key to help us remain at rest and keep worry at bay.

This second key is to simply *hear*. Hear messages that speak of the finished work of our Lord Jesus on the cross. Why? Because it has pleased God to save, heal, and deliver those who simply hear and believe the gospel through "the foolishness of preaching" (1 Corinthians 1:21, KJV).

Let me illustrate this truth with the healing of a crippled man recorded in Acts 14. In this amazing story, a man who had been crippled from his mother's womb and who had never walked in his life, leaped and walked after he *heard* the apostle Paul preach the gospel.

Acts 14:9 says, "This man heard Paul speaking." In the original Greek text, the word for "heard" is in the imperfect tense, meaning the man



kept on hearing Paul preach. Paul was preaching the *gospel* — the good news of how Jesus bore the full punishment on the cross for all of our sins and paid for us to walk in freedom, victory, and every blessing of God.

As the man heard and heard the gospel, faith arose in his heart. His legs might have been numb, but his heart certainly wasn't. In fact, his faith grew to the point Paul could see he had faith to be healed. When told, "*Stand up straight on your feet!*" (Acts 14:10), the man "*jumped up and walked around as if he'd been walking all his life*" (Acts 14:10b, THE MESSAGE). Such is the miracle-working power of simply hearing and hearing the preached Word!

Maybe you have felt crippled for a long time by something in your life, perhaps a chronic health problem or persistent debts. My friend, just start hearing messages that speak of our Lord Jesus' finished work and don't stop hearing! Continuous hearing about Jesus' finished work and grace is how faith comes into your heart for you to boldly receive your miracle (ref.: Romans 10:17, NASB; Galatians 3:5).

FLOW WITH HIS SPIRIT IN ALL THINGS

The third key the Lord has given us to help us experience Jubilee is to *flow* with the Holy Spirit. The root word for Jubilee in Hebrew is *yabal*, which means "to flow," the way a river does. You might be wondering, *What exactly does flowing with the Spirit mean?*

Let me explain. As a believer in Jesus cleansed of all sin by His blood, you have the Holy Spirit dwelling in you. He is known as the Helper and "*He will teach you all things*" and "*guide you into all truth*" (John 14:26, 16:13).

Faith to receive your miracle comes by continuously hearing about Jesus' finished work and grace.

For example, in teaching you to stay healthy, He might tell you in a gentle prompting, "You need to drink more water today." Or He might say, "You've been having late nights. Sleep earlier tonight." Perhaps you need to make an important decision, but aren't sure whether to

choose option A or option B. As you pray about both options, you'll sense His increasing peace in the choice that is right for you and a discomfort in the choice that isn't. That's how the Holy Spirit leads and guides you. He will also fill you with



God's strength to face life's challenges, remind you of God's unfailing love, and infuse your mind with God's shalom-peace in the midst of any storm of life (ref.: 2 Timothy 1:7).

Beloved, as you rest in Christ and keep hearing His Word preached, you will find His Spirit leading and guiding you to your breakthrough and victory.

FROM MULTIPLE BONDAGES TO TOTAL FREEDOM AND RESTORATION

Some time ago, I received a precious testimony from George, who experienced freedom from a disease that was relentlessly attacking his body and causing his life to spiral out of control. I want you to see how you can put into practice the very three keys I've shared earlier, just as George did — and see your Jubilee, just as George experienced his incredible breakthroughs.

Suffering from Evans syndrome, a disease that caused his immune system to attack and destroy

his platelets and red blood cells, George spent his days coping with ruptured blood vessels, sores and swelling in his tongue and mouth, frequent vomiting, and insomnia, just to mention a few of his symptoms. His medication made him so depressed that he had to tell his wife to hide their guns — so he wouldn't shoot himself to end his misery! He cried constantly and couldn't think or speak properly. His three children didn't know what was happening to their father. Nothing he did — including removing his spleen — improved his condition.

George's turning point came when he felt led by the Holy Spirit to watch the gospel of grace being preached via my television ministry. As he flowed with the inner leading of the Spirit who was teaching him how to be set free, he got hold of my sermons on Jesus' finished work and abundant grace, and started listening to them over and over again — at home, in the hospital, and even all through the night. He recalled, "Through your teachings, Daddy God showed me His love.

As you rest in Christ and keep hearing His Word preached, His Spirit will guide you to your breakthrough.

I went from feeling as if God was punishing me, to beholding the finished work of Jesus on the cross."

After listening to the sermons for about a month, George decided to surrender his condition to the Lord. He started thanking the Lord for his complete healing instead of focusing on his symptoms. He began to rest in God's promises and started to claim them as his own.

To cut a long story short, he is now completely free from Evans syndrome. He was also set free from back pain and acid reflux, which he had had for years. He and his wife now take the Lord's Supper daily to remind themselves of — and receive — the benefits of the Lord's finished work.

That's not all. George also experienced freedom from an 18-year addiction to cigarettes, marijuana, and has stopped watching pornography. He said, "I had tried many times to quit all three. I knew they were wrong, and I felt so condemned that

I couldn't succeed." But God miraculously took all his bondages away as he simply listened and listened to the gospel of grace. He said, "Now, Jesus has restored everything to me and it's all better than it was before. He has given me more strength and a lot more love. Now I know what true love is because of my Father's love and Jesus' love for me."

Praise the Lord, George is now a walking testimony of the Lord's goodness and Jubilee blessings to all who have seen the amazing transformation in him. The Lord gave George a fresh start as he simply rested in Him, listened and listened to messages about His finished work, and flowed with His Spirit.

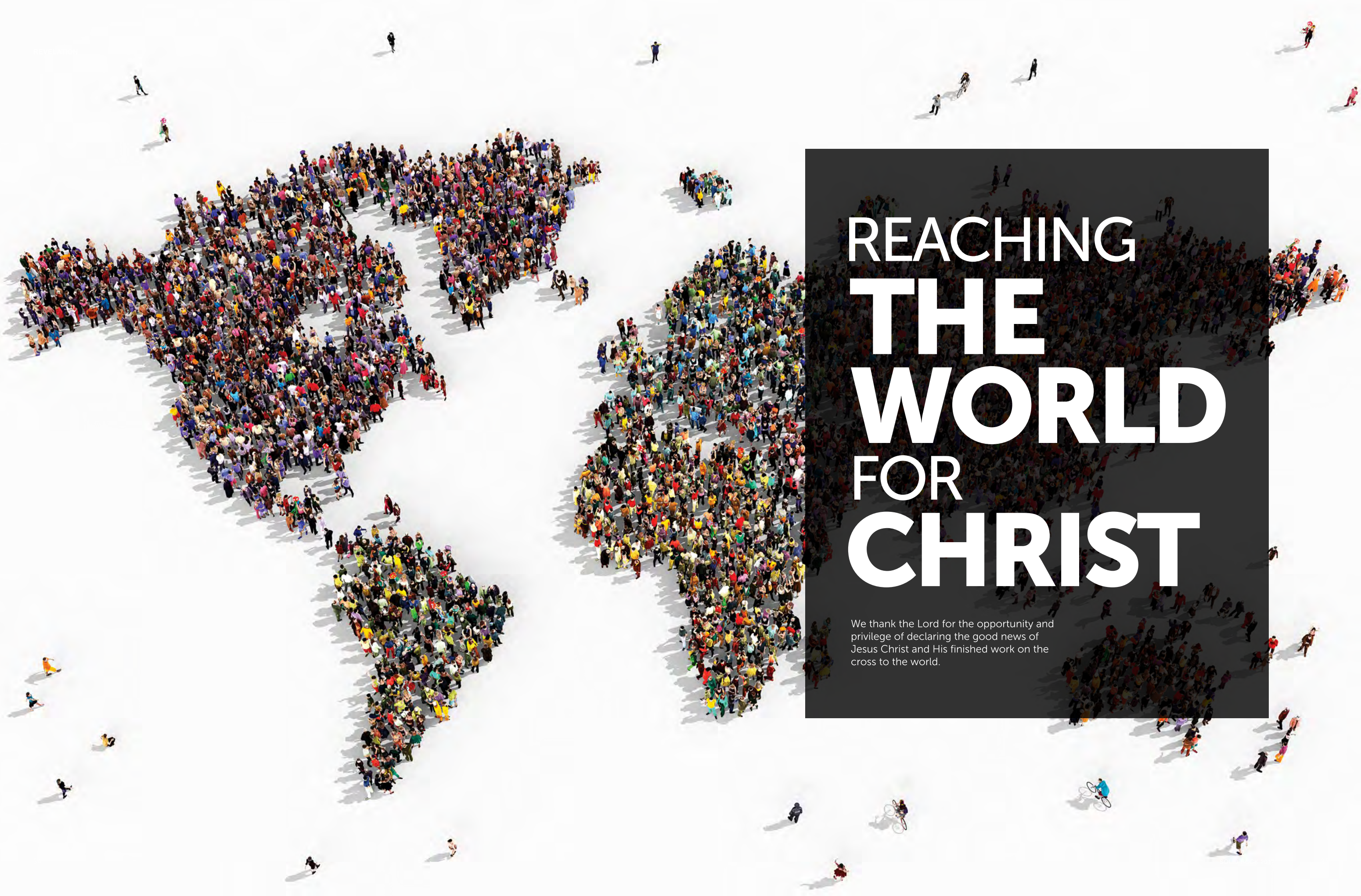

THE GOSPEL ON TELEVISION

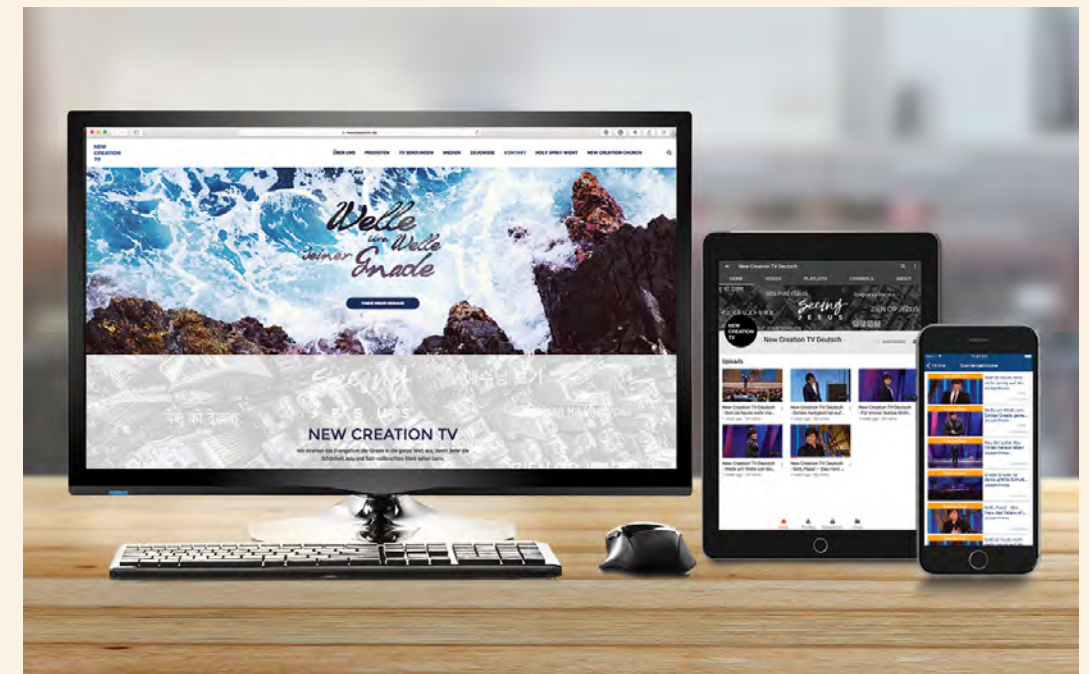

RECEIVED HEALING FOR HER LOWER BACK

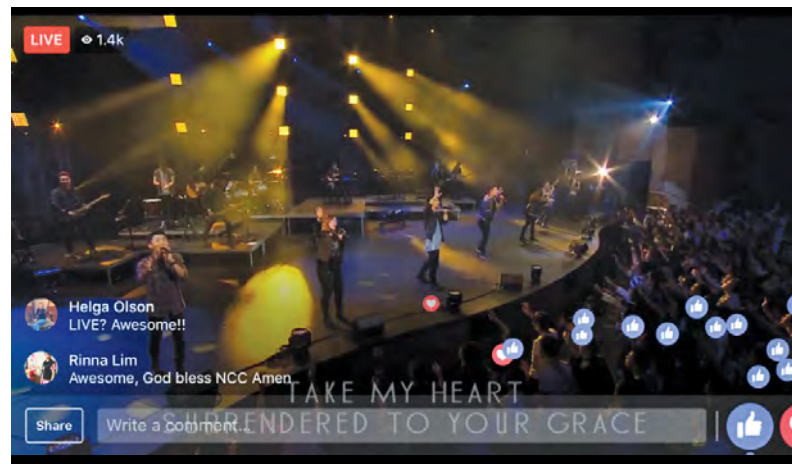
I had been experiencing pain in my left lower back for about a week and was unable to climb the stairs or squat down.

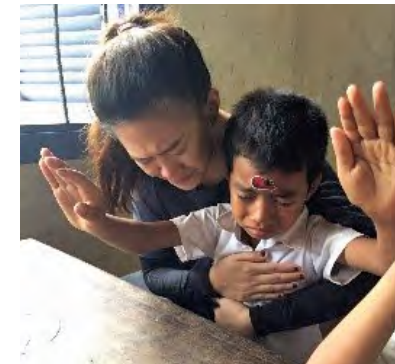

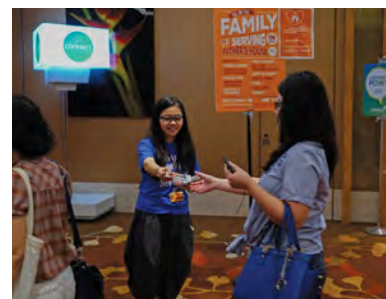

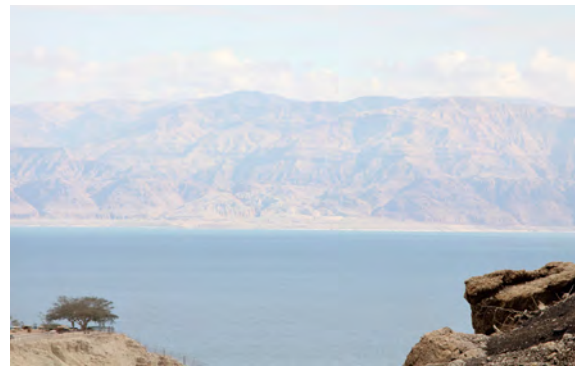

ANKLE PAIN GONE

Over the years, I had sustained multiple sprains in my ankle due to extreme sports. In February 2017, I suffered an injury in my right ankle, leaving it swollen and too painful to even move.

According to the doctor, I had snapped a few ligaments that were supporting my ankle. If I were to exert pressure on the ankle through extended walking, it would be inflamed.

As my work requires me to walk and stand on my feet for long hours, I was unable to give the ankle sufficient rest to heal properly. My colleagues were able to detect a slight limp to my gait and were quite concerned for me.

I was upset and did not know how to face the reality of not being able to be actively involved in sports again. It came to a point where I decided to accept the fact that I would probably be unable to maintain the active lifestyle that I once had.

On 15 April 2017, I was reading a devotion by Pastor Prince, and was inspired to actively declare that "by His stripes, I am healed" (ref.: Isaiah 53:5). I started declaring it to myself while placing my hand

LIFE TRANSFORMED AND BLESSED WITH BABY AFTER BELIEVING RIGHT

In 2006, I contracted Systemic Lupus Erythematosus (a chronic autoimmune disease that attacks healthy tissues). I had to take medication to suppress the symptoms. Over the next 10 years, I had a few outbreaks, and each time, I had to consume more and more medicine before my condition improved and the dosage could be reduced. This process was very painful.

I came from a traditional church in China where the teaching was full of condemnation and law. Subsequently, I developed severe depression. Thinking that I was demon-possessed, the church leadership tried to cast demons out of me. This was very hurtful and I spiralled into deeper condemnation, guilt and depression to the point that I could not fully control my behaviour.

I attempted suicide three times and became hostile to my family. I was bitter and couldn't forgive myself and others. I was suffering inside and my health deteriorated further.

At this time, I came to know about Pastor Prince's teachings, and started attending a care group. Since embracing God's grace, I began to understand that His love is unconditional and that He still loves me in spite of my shortcomings. I don't have to

"clean" myself before I go to the Lord to receive His love.

Every day, I would partake of the Holy Communion and declare that there would be a glorious restoration in my body and emotions, and that every area in my life would be well.

In May 2016, my medication was reduced to a minimum. My husband and I started to try for a baby but to no avail. I was worried that it was because of my heavy reliance on medication previously.

Since embracing God's grace, I began to understand that His love is unconditional.

I kept meditating on God's Word even though I was upset. I also remembered that the pastor of my current church would quote Pastor Prince's words saying that "right believing leads to right living".

So I began to change my mindset and look unto the Lord instead. Though I was undeserving, I knew that God is still willing to bless me. Praise Jesus, I finally became pregnant! On 6 April 2017, I gave birth to a healthy baby.

Now, I no longer indulge in self-pity and am able to forgive those who had hurt me in the past. I really believe there will be a grace revolution in the whole of China and that God's glory will manifest in the churches here.

That's not all that God did for me. I had to be on medication due to the stroke, and the side effect of it was a burning pain in my left shoulder.

Amazingly, by God's grace, the pain left immediately. I thought that the pain might come back again but guess what? It has been over a year and the pain has not come back!
