

RULES & REGULATIONS

PINK WIG-A-THON CHARITY RUN 2019

1. The **PINK-WIG-A-THON CHARITY RUN 2019** ("the Event") is organized by **PINK RIBBON WELLNESS [L] FOUNDATION** ("the Organiser") with the full support of **DEWAN BANDARAYA KUALA LUMPUR** ("DBKL") and in accordance with the **PINK WIG-A-THON CHARITY RUN 2019** Rules & Regulations.

2. ORGANISER'S RIGHTS

2.1 By signing up for and providing any information, personal or otherwise, in order to gain access to any product(s) and/or service(s) and/or participate in any programme(s), event(s), talk(s), or any other activities involving the Organiser and the Event sponsors ("the Sponsors"), the individual ("the Participant") is deemed to have given explicit permission for the Organiser and the Sponsors to collect, analyse, collate, share, disclose to third parties and/or otherwise use without any liability to the individual, any personal information relating to that individual as may in its sole discretion deem fit, including without any limitation for its programmes, planning, data-processing and statistical or risk-analysis, research, fund-raising and/or any other purposes in furtherance of the functions. The Organiser and the Sponsors declare by virtue of being the Event owner or sponsor, they can use the services of third parties.

2.1.1 For development or implementation of programmes, products or services as it may deem necessary;

2.1.2 For outsourcing of any programme(s), event(s), talk(s) and/or any activities;

2.1.3 For promotional, marketing and/or administrative purposes;

2.1.4 For all purposes as required by law, including without limitation court proceedings, criminal investigations or prosecutions or where so ordered by any competent authority;

2.1.5 In connection with any proposed novation, assignment, transfer, sale, lease, license, partnership, joint-organizing and/or any collaboration where and when required in relation thereto

2.2 **This Event will be held on 22nd September 2019 [Sunday]** at 6.30 am to 12.00 pm.

- 2.3 The Organiser reserves the right to cancel or postpone the Event at any time without prior notice to the Participants, in which case the Organiser will make effort to inform the Participants prior to the date of the Event. If the Event has to be canceled or postponed, there shall be no refunds of fees or donations paid unless the Organiser deems fit to give a refund and the Organiser shall not be held liable for any loss or inconvenience caused.
- 2.4 The Organiser reserves the right to modify or substitute any of these Rules and Regulations of the Event from time to time as they deem fit. If there is ambiguity in any of the provisions, the Organiser shall be the authority to interpret and in doing so, the Organiser will take into account the interests of all the affected Participants. Any updates on the Rules and Regulations of the Event will be notified on the official Event's Registration Portal and it is the responsibility of the affected Participant to keep abreast with any changes.
- 2.5 The Organiser reserves the right to amend the Event race routes as they deem fit for the safety of the Participants and/or to prevent any potential hazards in the running of the Event, at any time without prior notice to the Participants. In such cases, every effort will be made to inform the Participants prior to the date of the Event. The Organiser shall not be held liable for any loss or inconvenience caused due to such changes.
- 2.6 If the Participant's original bib number is lost or cannot be found during Race Pack Collection, the Organiser reserves the right to replace it with a spare bib number. The Organiser reserves the right to amend or substitute any Participant's running bib at any time without prior notice to the Participant.
- 2.7 The Organiser reserves the right to use any photographs (including those of Participants), motion pictures, recordings, or any other media records of the Event, for any legitimate purpose including commercial advertising and distribution to Sponsors anywhere in the world.
- 2.8 The Organiser reserves the right to limit and/or refuse entry to the Event and/or another programme (s), event(s), talk(s), or any other activities involving the Organiser and the event sponsors without giving any reason and/or notice.
- 2.9 The Organiser will not be responsible for any loss and/or damage, personal or otherwise, to the belongings and items deposited at the event baggage storage provided for the runners. The Organiser also reserves the right to check any item or baggage deposited.

3. PARTICIPANT'S RESPONSIBILITIES

- 3.1 The Participant hereby agrees to release and hold harmless the Organiser, **PINK RIBBON WELLNESS [L] FOUNDATION** and **DEWAN BANDARAYA KUALA LUMPUR**, its officers, directors, agents, employees, property owners, instructors and associates from and against any liability, all manner of actions and causes of actions, judgements executions, debts, claims and demands of every kind and nature whatsoever arising out of any injury loss, damage, death caused to property or any other person arising from or in connection with the participant's participation in the event whether such injury loss, damage, death was caused directly or indirectly by negligence, breach of contract or any way whatsoever arising from training for, during, or after participation in the Event.
- 3.2 The Participant also certify and declare that the Participant is not at present under any form of medical treatment for physical infirmity, chronic illness, or mental disorder that could affect participation in the Event. Participants are also strongly encouraged to go for a medical examination and/or consult their medical practitioner prior to registration and before the actual Event Day.
- 3.3 Completion of the official entry form, including online registration, confirms the Participant's agreement to abide by all the relevant Rules and Regulations of the **PINK WIG-A-THON CHARITY RUN 2019**, Organiser and Sponsors.
- 3.4 Registration for the race is only confirmed upon payment made and upon issuance of a race identification number.
- 3.5 In consideration of the Participant's use of the Event's website, the Participant agree to;
 - 3.5.1 Provide true, accurate, current and complete information contained in any registration form (such information being the "Registration Data")
 - 3.5.2 Maintain the security of their password and identification.
 - 3.5.3 Maintain and promptly update the registration data to keep it true, accurate, current and complete. The Organiser may contact the Participant from time to time by email or through other mode of communication. Any notice sent to the email address registered with the Organiser shall be deemed as received by the Participants. If the Participant provides any information that is untrue, inaccurate, obsolete or incomplete, or the Organiser has grounds to suspect that such information is untrue, inaccurate, obsolete or incomplete, the Organiser may suspend or terminate their registration and refuse any and all current or future use of the Event's website (or any parts thereof).
- 3.6 It is the responsibility of Participant to understand their respective Event Route of 5km or 10km.

- 3.7 The Organizer will not entertain nor be in any way responsible for any disputes arising from incomplete or inaccurate entry details in the registration form.
- 3.8 **Participants are strictly not allowed to transfer their race entries to another party or change race categories after their registrations have been confirmed.**

4. REFUND

- 4.1 There will be strictly no refund available if the Event is cancelled for reason of force majeure i.e. due to the occurrence of incidents that are beyond the control of the Organiser or acts of God which renders it impossible or unsafe to hold the Event.
- 4.2 Once registration has been duly processed, there will be NO ENTRY FEE refund for Participant who does not eventually participate in the Event for whatever reason.

5. SAFETY

- 5.1 While every reasonable precaution will be taken by the Organiser to ensure the Participants' safety, Participants are solely responsible for their own safety and the Organiser will not be responsible or held liable for any injury or death howsoever arising from training for, during, or after the participation in the Event. Participants are strongly encouraged to go for a medical examination and/or consult their medical practitioner prior to registration and before the actual Event Day.
- 5.2 Partial road closures on the **ENTIRE ROUTE** will be lifted after three (3) hours from the start of the 10km race. Cut-off times will be set at specific checkpoints along the route to ensure the safety of runners who are not able to complete the race within the three (3) hours and to ensure that the roads can be re-opened to the public in accordance with the Event Permit.
- 5.3 A Participant must follow their respective Event Route, the direction of security officers/officials, traffic management officers/officials, Event's officers/officials and any enforcement officers/officials.
- 5.4 A Participant must retire from the race immediately, if required to do so by any member of the Official, Medical Staff, Race Director, Marshall, and/or Security officer.
- 5.5 Pets, bicycle, in-line skates, prams, push carts, shoes with built-in or attached rollers and other wheel-run objects are **not ALLOWED** on the 5 km and 10 km course other than official race and medical vehicles.

6. DISQUALIFICATION

- 6.1 Any Participant who commences running before the actual flag-off of his/her registered race category will be disqualified immediately. (Please refer to individual race category start times).
- 6.2 Participants will be disqualified if do not start within 15 minutes of respective flag offs (10km – 7.00 am and 5km – 7.20 am), for safety reasons.
- 6.3 Participants must wear the assigned bib number visibly on his/her chest at all times. Participants who do not display bib numbers will be taken off the course by security officers/officials and will be disqualified.

7. ELIGIBILITY

- 7.1 The Event is open for registration to all persons legally residing in Malaysia as at the date of the Event [Malaysian and NON-Malaysian]
- 7.2 Participants must be 6 years old or older as of Event Day to participate in the Event.
- 7.3 Participants below the age of 6 are required to obtain parental/guardian's consent and complete the relevant indemnity declaration form as deemed necessary by the Organiser upon registration, failing which, the Organiser reserves the right to refuse entry to any applicant under the age of 6 years.
- 7.4 Children age 6-12 years old must be accompanied by an adult participating in the same category.

8. RACE PACK COLLECTION

- 8.1 All Participants must collect their Race Pack which contains their bib number, event t-shirt, and other sponsored items [If any] during Race Pack Collection (RPC) during the predetermined period and location as stipulated on the Event's website. T-shirt sizes are subjected to availability on first-come-first-serve basis.
- 8.2 To collect your race pack, you must bring the printout of your confirmation slip and your NRIC/passport. You may appoint a representative to collect your race pack on your behalf. The representative must present the following:
- Printout of your confirmation slip
 - Letter of authorization signed by you
 - Representative's IC/passport
 - Photocopy of your IC/passport
- 8.3 All Race Packs not collected during RPC stipulated time and date, will be deemed to be unwanted, and the Organiser shall be at liberty to dispose or re-distribute them accordingly.

9. GENERAL RULES

- 9.1 Each Participant is allowed to win only one award in the category that he/she has registered for if he/she is declared the winner.
- 9.2 The Organiser reserves the right to replace any winners if he/she is found to be disqualified.
- 9.3 Winners must report to the prize giving zone as stipulated on their winner tag. In case a participant fails to do so, the award will be given to the next winner in line.
- 9.4 **All prize-winning Participants must present their original identification document (such as Passport or Identity Card) to collect their prize.**
- 9.5 For all disputes, the Organiser's decision is final and no other disputes thereafter will be entertained.
- 9.7 First 3,000 Participants who successfully complete the 5km fun walk, and 10km run will be awarded a finisher medal upon presentation of their bib number to the respective staff.

9.8 All finisher medals must be collected on Event Day and no requests will be entertained thereafter.
