景福宫

首尔

- 景福宫 - 是李朝 (1392-1910年) 时期首尔的五大宫之一, 也是李氏王朝的正宫, 具有 500 年历史。景福宫是李朝的始祖——太祖李成桂 (1392-1398 年在位) 于1395年将原来高丽的首都迁移时建造的新王朝的宫殿。
- 清溪川 - 是首尔市民和游客的休息观光地点, 沿途经过不少地方, 连东大门都可见其身影, 每一段皆有 不同的景色。
- 爱情锁墙 - 韩国代表性的爱情景点。

江原道

- 雪岳山国家公园 - 游览新兴寺青铜座佛像, 称为统一大佛, 历经11年完成, 是韩国最大的青铜佛像。
- 大浦港海产市场 - 这里聚集众多刚捕捞上来的海产, 专卖给商人。在这繁忙的鱼市场里您可以自费品尝各种独特新鲜的海产。
- 朝韩非军事区 - 江原道拥有一个世界上独一无二的区域, DMZ 非军事区。DMZ 即 Demilitarized Zone 的缩写, 意为非武装地带。这是指朝韩双方在所属领地内以北纬 38 度为界线, 各自后退 2 公里而划出了一块军事缓冲区。DMZ 是把韩国国土分裂成北与南的分界线, 标志着因战争和分裂给人民带来的痛苦, 这条分界线的存在, 使得江原道成为世界上唯一分裂的地区。从韩国战争结束以来, 这里禁止行人出入, 因此仍然完美保留着原始生态环境, 具有较大的自然环境价值。但是最近 DMZ 非军事区逐渐面向一般人开放。这里是野生动物的天堂, 也是世界上最著名的生态宝地之一, 自开放以来, 就深受瞩目。
- 自由之桥 - 是当时朝韩返还俘虏的地方, 桥的一端铁栅栏上挂满了丝带, 人们在上面写着希望统一的美好心愿。
- 临津阁公园 - 参观韩国战争中使用的大炮。
- 乌头山统一瞭望台 - 可以在此看到朝鲜城市开城。
- 抱川艺术区 - 废旧采石场到艺术谷的变身, 小山丘上千奇百怪的岩石和不着边际的山景湖让废旧的采石场重新获得生机。曾经的废墟在抱川市环境还原政策的推动下, 展现出全新的面貌, 已成为深受游客和当地居民喜爱的文化艺术空间。也是韩剧《蓝色大海的传说》, 《步步惊心丽》和《花游记》取景地。

SEOUL

- **Gyeongbok Palace** - Built in 1395, Gyeongbokgung Palace is also commonly referred to as the "Northern Palace" because it is the furthest north when compared to the neighboring palaces. Gyeongbokgung Palace is arguably the most beautiful and remains the grandest of all five palaces.
- **Cheonggyecheon Stream** - existed only as a neglected waterway hidden by an overpass. Today, it has been transformed into a haven of natural beauty amidst the bustle of city life.
- **Love of Locks** - Thousands of padlocks attached to the fence by romantic Seoulites symbolizing their undying affection.

GANGWON-DO

- **Mt. Sorak National Park** – we will visit Sinhung Temple, which reflects the harmonization of nature and music.
- **Daepohang Fish Market** – where you can taste a variety of fresh and unique seafood like seasoned squids and long leg crabs, and buy roadside snacks. (on own expenses)
- **DMZ** – The Demilitarized Zone (DMZ) is a weapons-free buffer zone between North and South Korea. The area was established on July 27, 1953 when the Armistice Agreement was signed during the Korean War, and includes the 2km-wide stretch of land both north and south of the line. The DMZ extends largely from Gyeonggi-do to Gangwon-do, including seven different cities and smaller counties of Paju, Yeoncheon, Cheorwon, Hwacheon, Yanggu, Inje and Goseong. The zone has been protected from human disturbance for about 6 decades and has unintentionally become a haven for wildlife, making it a popular destination for nature lovers.
- **Bridge of Freedom** – which the South Koreans who fled the North during the war crossed when returning to their homeland.
- **Imjinggak** – A park and a monument, and includes a three-story building housing photos, documents, and anticommunist relics from North Korea. It was built in 1972, as a consolation for North Koreans living in the South who were unable to return to their homes and see their families and friends. It is a testament to the hopes of many Koreans that unification may be possible someday.
- **Odusan Unification Observatory** – Here you can see the city of North Korea.
- **Pocheon Art Valley** – A former quarry transformed into a culture and arts space. Oddly shaped rocks and a beautiful lake were once a closed quarry. The transformation was the outcome of Korea's first environment restoration project led by Pocheon-si. As of now, more than 1 million tourists visit this place every year. It's also a popular culture and art complex loved by local residents.
