## ARNHEM

- Open Air Museum** - The Netherlands Open Air Museum is an open-air museum located in Arnhem with antique houses, farms, and factories from different parts of the Netherlands. It is a national museum focusing on the culture associated with the everyday lives of ordinary people. This will be linked to key aspects of Dutch history, including the Dutch East India Company and Michiel de Ruyter, as well as the First World War, slavery, and child labor. The park was established on 24 April 1912 and opened to the public in July 1918, over the last century the Netherlands Open Air Museum has grown to become one of the country's most visited museums.

## KINDERDIJK

- Windmills** - The windmills at Kinderdijk are a group of 19 monumental windmills in the Alblasserwaard polder, in the province of South Holland, Netherlands. Most of the mills are part of the village of Kinderdijk in the municipality of Molenlanden, and one mill, De Blokker, is part of the municipality of Alblasserdam. Built-in 1738 and 1740, to keep water out of the polder, it is the largest concentration of old windmills in the Netherlands and one of the best-known Dutch tourist sites. The mills are listed as national monuments and the entire area is a protected village view since 1993. They have been a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1997.

## ROTTERDAM

- Cube Houses** - Cube houses are a set of innovative houses built in Helmond and Rotterdam in the Netherlands, designed by architect Piet Blom and based on the concept of "living as an urban roof": high-density housing with sufficient space on the ground level since its main purpose is to optimize the space inside. Blom tilted the cube of a conventional house 45 degrees and rested it upon a hexagon-shaped pylon. His design represents a village within a city, where each house represents a tree, and all the houses together, a forest. The central idea of the cube houses around the world is mainly optimizing the space, as a house, to a better distribution of the rooms inside.

## GIETHOORN

- Giethoorn Village** - Giethoorn is a village in the Dutch province of Overijssel. It's about an hour and a half drive from Amsterdam and is known for being very pretty as it contains very few roads and much of the village can only be reached by foot or boat. There are many canals and bridges (more than 180 bridges) which only adds to its picturesque charm. Most of the houses and cottages have thatched roofs so it feels a little as if you have stepped back in time as you walk along the footpath by the canal admiring the pretty homes and perhaps stopping for lunch at one of the canal-side cafes or restaurants.

## VOLEDAM

- Volendam Village** - Volendam is a popular tourist attraction in the Netherlands, well known for its old fishing boats and the traditional clothing still worn by some residents. The women's costume of Volendam, with its high, pointed bonnet, is one of the most recognizable of the Dutch traditional costumes and is often featured on tourist postcards and posters (although there are believed to be fewer than 50 women now wearing the costume as part of their daily lives, most of them elderly). There is a regular ferry connection to Marken, a peninsula close by. Volendam also features a small museum about its history and clothing style, and visitors can have their pictures taken in traditional Dutch costumes.

## AMSTERDAM

- **Zaanse Schans** - The Zaanse Schans is a residential area in which the 18th and 19th centuries are brought to life. Despite the fact that visitors from all over the world visit this neighborhood every day, it is good to know that people still live here. Keep this in mind during your visit. Stroll past the bakery museum and enjoy the smell of fresh cookies, or take a look at the warehouse where clogs are made. You should be sure not to miss the cheese factory, pewter foundry, and the various windmills. The Zaanse Schans is a unique part of the Netherlands, full of wooden houses, mills, barns, and workshops.
- **Heineken Museum** - The Heineken Experience is an attraction located at the Heineken's first built brewery in Amsterdam's city center. In 1988, the brewery was closed due to the inability to meet the high demand. Nowadays, you can learn about Heineken's heritage, brewing process, innovations, sponsorships, and what it takes to serve a star in a 1.5-hour self-guided tour. At the end of the tour you can, of course, enjoy two Heinekens.

## MUIDEN

- **Muiden Castle** - The Muiderslot is one of Holland's most picturesque medieval castles. With a long and rich history, the castle is now a national museum and open for the public to explore its awe-inspiring rooms (restored to how they looked in the 17th century), as well as its collection of arms and armor.

## AALSMEER

- **Flower Auction** - The Aalsmeer flower auction in North Holland near Amsterdam Schiphol Airport is by far the busiest floral market in the world. Daily, around 20 million flowers are traded here. Visitors are welcome but must arrive early and only observe the action from walkways several meters above the flowers and the busy warehouse floor where mini transportation trains crisscross the world's largest covered market at astonishing speed.

## ALMERE

- **Floriade Expo 2022** - Floriade Expo 2022 is a Dutch horticultural exposition to be held in Almere, Netherlands. It will be the 23rd AIPH world horticultural exhibition and the seventh Floriade and will be held from 14 April to 9 October 2022. Visit Floriade Expo 2022 and discover solutions from national and international innovators that make our cities more fun, more beautiful and more sustainable. At the Floriade Park you can enjoy the scent and color of flowers, plants, vegetables and fruit. And that's just the beginning of all the things you can experience.
