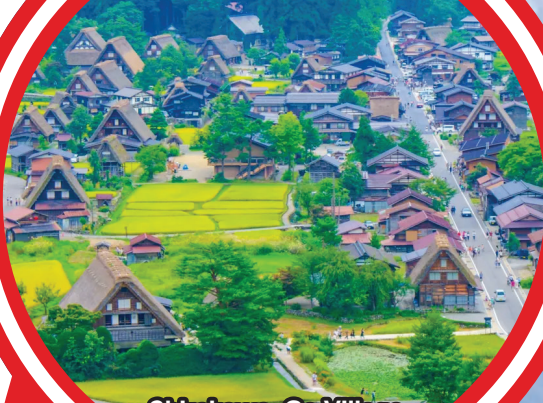

TOURIST ATTRACTIONS:

TOKYO

- ◆ **Sensoji** - Sensoji (also known as Asakusa Kannon Temple) is a Buddhist temple located in Asakusa. It is one of Tokyo's most colorful and popular temples. You may enjoy shopping at the lively street call Nakamise-dori Street in front of the temple.
- ◆ **Imperial Palace** - is located on the former site of Edo Castle, a large park area surrounded by moats and massive stone walls in the center of Tokyo, a short walk from Tokyo Station. It is the residence of Japan's Imperial Family.

HAKONE

- ◆ **Mount Fuji** - rising above the clouds, is the symbol of Japan and has provided a spiritual basis for the Japanese since ancient times, with the height of 3776meter. With unrivaled magnificence and a beautiful cone shape, Mt. Fuji has often been favored as the subject of paintings and literature throughout the centuries, and is now globally known as the symbol of Japan.
- ◆ **Lake Ashi Pirate Ship** - was formed in the caldera of Mt. Hakone after the volcano's last eruption 3000 years ago. Enjoy the boat ride while glazing the delight.

SHIRAKAWA-GO

- ◆ **Shirakawa-go Village** - the Historic Villages of Shirakawa-gō are one of Japan's UNESCO World Heritage Sites. These villages are well known for their houses constructed in the architectural style known as gash O-zukuri. The Gasshō-zukuri, "prayer-hands construction" style is characterized by a thatched and steeply slanting roof resembling two hands joined in prayer. The design is exceptionally strong and, in combination with the unique properties of the thatching, allow the houses to withstand and shed the weight of the region's heavy snowfalls in winter.
- ◆ **Wada House** - was built in the middle of the Edo period, giving it a proud history of more than three hundred years. It's the largest gasshō-style private residence in Shirakawa village, and is a nationally designated Important Cultural Property. It's called Wada House because the Wada family is still currently living here, using the space on the premises that's not open to the public.

TAKAYAMA

- ◆ **Takayama Old Town** - Alpine Streets retaining the traditional Japanese style, walking in the Edo period in Japan among the primary building ancient taste, elegant and quiet atmosphere, showing the traditional beauty of Japanese culture, the alpine region's most popular tourist attractions.

TATEYAMA KUROBE ALPINE

- ◆ **Tateyama Kurobe Alpine Route** - a famous mountain sightseeing route between Tateyama, Toyama and Omachi, Nagano, Japan. The route is just 37 km in length, but the vertical interval is as large as 1,975m. It uses 6 different public transports with 5 different modes, namely funicular, bus, trolleybus, aerial tramway, and walking. Take cable car from Tateyama Station to Bijodaira enjoy the Beautiful Woman Cedar viewing. Then highland bus to Murodo, and take tunnel trolley bus, you can enjoy the snow corridor. Then continue to journey by trolley bus to Daikanbo. Then take ropeway to Kurobedaira station. You can see the highest arch dam in Japan which about 1500m.

KYOTO

- ◆ **Fushimi Inari-Taisha** - the shrine sits at the base of a mountain also named Inari which is 233 meters above sea level. Early Japan, Inari was seen as the patron of business merchants and manufactures have traditionally worshipped Inari. Each of the torii at Fushimi Inari Taisha is donated by a Japanese business. First and foremost, though, Inari is the god of rice.
- ◆ **Kiyomizu Temple** - the temple is renowned for its construction which uses no nails to support the elaborate wooden structure of the main hall. And with a quaint old lane lined with pottery shops lead up to this famous temple.

观光景点：

东京

- ◆ **浅草雷门观音寺** - 建于7世纪的佛庙，其象征物是风雷神门，上面挂着写有“雷门”两个字的大红灯笼，这里每天都有前来参拜的观光客，终年熙熙攘攘。您也可在该寺前的热闹街道“仲世见”购物，此处满布出售各种纪念品的商铺以及当地小吃的日式店铺。
- ◆ **皇居** - 位于东京市中心，护城河和石墙围绕着广大的绿地，离东京车站仅数步之遥。日本皇室现居于此。皇居前的大广场称为皇居外苑，游客可由皇居外苑观赏二道桥，这两座桥是通往皇宫内的入口处。

箱根

- ◆ **富士山** - 富士山海拔3776米，是日本的第一高峰。它气势雄伟，是其他山峰所不及，呈圆锥形的山姿十分优美，常常被用来作为绘画和文字的创作题材，它作为日本的象征，名扬全世界。
- ◆ **芦之湖海盗船** - 乘海盗船游览背倚着富士山的芦之湖，湖山相映，不同的季节有不同的景致和情趣。

白川乡

- ◆ **合掌村** - 于1995年列入世界文化遗产，因为冬天的景色如同童话故事中情景一般，故被誉为『冬日的童话村』。这是日本一种特殊的民宅形式，特色是以茅草覆盖的屋顶，呈人字型的屋顶如同双手合十一般，于是就被称为【合掌】。合掌造为木造建筑物，在兴建的过程中完全不用钉子，但仍然十分坚固。合掌造的屋顶十分陡峭，这是使积雪容易滑落不会堆积，以避免冬季的大雪将屋顶压垮。
- ◆ **和田家** - 建于江户时代中期，在白川乡是拥有300年以上悠久历史的最大规模合掌造民家，也是国家指定重要文化财。如同“和田家”这个名字，和田一家仍然居住在展示部分以外的空间。

高山

- ◆ **高山古街** - 高山古街保留传统日式风格，走在日本江户时代原色古味的建筑当中，幽雅静谧的气氛，展现了日本文化传统美，是高山地区有人气旅游景点。自古以来，一直是飞驒地区(现在的岐阜县北部)经济重地的高山古街有著“飞驒的小京都”之称。

立山黑部

- ◆ **立山黑部【雪の大谷】** - 是从富山地方铁道的立山车站到长野县扇泽的全长约86公里的山岳道路。初春的立山黑部，踏入高达18公尺的壮观雪墙，令人叹为观止。贯穿日本屋脊的立山黑部。阿尔卑斯的连绵山峰，漫游其中并乘坐六种交通工具，领略峻山之雄伟大自然风景。环山之自然森林，沿途90公里风景迷人。从“美女平”车站开始，到“室堂站”，游览雪之壁。随后到“大观峰站”，由车站的屋顶展望台，可眺望日本阿尔卑斯山脉及黑部水库之壮观全景，是阿尔卑斯山脉路线中屈指可数之美景。接着到“黑部水库”，建设于海拔1500公尺高，为日本第一高处的拱形水库。在立山阿尔卑斯路线的终站“扇泽”结束惊为天人的雪谷之行。

京都

- ◆ **伏见稻荷神社** - 每年都有大量的香客前来神社祭拜祈求农作丰收，生意兴隆，交通安全。另外起源于江户时代的习俗，前来此地许愿的人们往往会捐款在神社境内竖立一座鸟居来表达对神明的敬意，使其神社的范围内竖有数量惊人的大小鸟居，而以【千本鸟居】之名而闻名日本全国乃至海外。
- ◆ **京都清水寺** - 历史悠久的寺庙，整座建筑完全不用铁打钉锁。沿途坡道两旁是日式古老建筑及商店，摆满了各种各式的日本手工艺品，陶瓷，日本娃娃等，不胜枚举。
