THESSALONIKI

- **White Tower** - is the most commonly known monument of Thessaloniki and the symbol of the city because of its prominent position, long history and imposing architecture.
- **Agios Dimitrios** - is arguably considered the most important church of Thessaloniki. Devoted to the patron Saint of the city, it has a long and rich history. Agios Dimitrios unique in terms of religious art. It unusual hexagonal shrine (ciborium), while the older 5th century mosaics are of special value and beauty.

KALAMBAKA

- **Kalampaka** - is situated on the foot of the most extraordinary Meteora rocks. It is a town with a very rich and long history in itself.
- **Meteora** - is a rock formation in central Greece hosting one of the largest and most precipitously built complexes of Eastern Orthodox monasteries. The six (of an original twenty four) monasteries are built on immense natural pillars and hill-like rounded boulders that dominate the local area. It is located near the town of Kalambaka at the northwestern edge of the Plain of Thessaly near the Pineios river and Pindus Mountains. Meteora is listed as UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- **Temple of Apollo** - Ruins of the ancient Temple of Apollo at Delphi, overlooking the valley of Phocis. Greeks considered Delphi the navel (or centre) of the world, as represented by the stone monument known as the Omphalos of Delphi. It is recognised by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site in having had a phenomenal influence in the ancient world, as evidenced by the rich monuments built there by most of the important ancient Greek city-states, demonstrating their fundamental Hellenic unity.

SANTORINI

- **Santorini** - classically Thera and officially Thira, is an island in the southern Aegean Sea, about 200 km southeast of Greece's mainland. The municipality of Santorini includes the inhabited islands of Santorini and Therasia. The major settlements include Fira, Oia, Emporio, Kamari, Perissa, Imerovigli, Pyrgos, and Therasia.
- **Oia Village** - or Ia is a small village and former community in the South Aegean on the islands of Thira (Santorini) and Therasia, in the Cyclades, Greece. It is a traditional village with charming houses in narrow streets, blue domed churches, and sun-bathed verandas. It is known throughout the world for its quiet life and fantastic sunset, and is certainly the most beautiful and picturesque village of Santorini.
- **Fira Village** - Fira also know as Thira, is the capital city of Santorini since the early years of the 19th century. It was built on the edge of the Caldera rim, enjoying stunning views of the sunken volcano and the opposite islands (Thirassia, Nea and Palea Kameni). Nowadays Fira is the most important cultural and trade centre of Santorini with many shops, restaurants, bars, cafes and etc. The village is very picturesque with whitewashed houses and narrow streets, blue domed churches, narrow stone stairways and imposing venetian manors dating back to the 19th century.

- **Pyrgos Village** - is a village on the Aegean island of Santorini, Greece. Pyrgos is well-know for its churches and monasteies Famoso per le sue chiese e monasteri (the most important one is the Monastery of Profitis Iliia), narrow street and cafes with views, Pyrgos has been the capital of Santorini until the early years of the 19th century.

ATHENS

- **Athens** - is the historic city and capital of Greece. Athens lies 8 km from the Bay of Phaleron, an inlet of the Aegean Sea where Piraeus, the port of Athens, is situated, in a mountain-girt arid basin divided north-south by a line of hills. Many of Classical civilization's intellectual and artistic ideas originated there, and the city is generally considered to be the birthplace of Western civilization.
- **Acropolis** - is a citadel built on a high hill, constructed during the late 5th century BC during the 'Golden Age of Athens', the Acropolis was built to honour the city's patron goddess Athena. The ancient city of the Acropolis includes the Parthenon, the Erechtheion, the Temple of Athena Nike and the Propylea, the most famous being the Parthenon.
- **Syntagma Square** - is the central square of Athens. The square is named after the Constitution that Otto, the first King of Greece, was obliged to grant after a popular and military uprising on 3 September 1843.
- **Tomb of the Unknown Soldier** - is a war memorial located in Syntagma Square in Athens, in front of the Old Royal Palace. It is a cenotaph dedicated to the Greek soldiers killed during war. It was sculpted between 1930-32 by sculptor Fokion Rok.


