

Makeup and its History

- Makeup is an Art and Science.
- Makeup helps to enhance the beauty features and hides the bad one.
- It grooms , and gives full confidence and attract others.
- It all goes back to the ancient (4000BC) **Egyptians**, who were the first women to wear makeup. In a way, the basic motive back then was the same as it is today- just like modern day supermodels, the well-to-do women of ancient Egypt wanted to look their best and saw the careful application of face-paint as a means to that end.
- They used kohl (burnt almond) for makeup . They thought that it makes their eye cool and increase the visuality
- Next the makeup tradition started at Rome. They used to paint their face white using chalk and blush using rose petals. According to them white is the symbol of beauty.
- Next the makeup tradition came to Persian. They used to apply henna all over the body along with hair to turn it in to orange . They thought that orange is the symbol that takes them close to mother earth.
- Next the Japanese people started to do makeup. They are the first one who started to draw eyebrows ,eye liner and lipsticks using sunflower petals.

A **makeup brush** is a tool with bristles, used for the application of **makeup** or face painting. The bristles may be made out of natural or synthetic materials, while the handle is usually made out of plastic or wood. When **cosmetics** are applied using the appropriate **brush**, they blend better into the skin
