DAY 1: ARRIVAL / TROMSØ

Arrival in Tromsø. Your tourleader will meet you upon arrival at the hotel.

Located at 69 degrees north - Tromsø is 320 km above the Arctic Circle - visitors are amazed when they discover that this city has hotels with international standard, lively cafes, world class seafood restaurants, an active cultural life, an exciting nightlife, museums and captivating art galleries.

Overnight at the Hotel Thon Tromsø or similar

DAY 2: TROMSØ

After Scandinavian breakfast , Depart for a panoramic tour of two hours. You will discover this city between fjords and mountains. Admire the Arctic Cathedral (outside) with its strange architecture creating an iceberg effect. Walk through the old city that retains partially pedestrianized old wooden houses with well-chosen colors, where you can discover the largest wooden cathedral in Norway (entrance not included).

You have a free afternoon to explore the city, visit one of the many museums or have a beer in the northernmost brewery in the world. Evening departure for a hunt at dawn accompanied by specialists of the Northern Lights. To succeed, the guides are based on satellites that observe the evolution of the phenomenon and choose the place of observation based on these data.

.* Please note that the Northern Lights (Aurora Borealis) are a natural phenomenon and sightings cannot be guaranteed.

Overnight at Hotel Thon Tromsø or similar.

Day 3: TROMSØ / NARVIK (250 KM)

After Scandinavian breakfast, You will head to the Tromsø region and discover the different immaculate landscapes and sometimes you will find yourself flowing between walls of snow! You will experience the northernmost zoo in the world.

Continuation to Narvik, the famous port city. This city is also known to have been a strategic place during the Second World War.

Optional tour of the Narvik War Museum.

Overnight at the hotel Scandic Narvik or similar.

DAY 4: NARVIK / ANDENES (290 KM)

After Scandinavian breakfast we will Depart for Vesterålen - A kingdom filled with hundreds of large and small islands that form a beautiful natural landscape. The land consists of mountains, rolling hills, deep valleys, white sandy beaches, colorful fishermen houses and narrow fjords.

You will visit a reindeer farm and discover the typical regional animal. You will sit around the fire, visit the reindeer herds, and feed them. Continuation to Andenes - northern tip of Vesterålen.

Dinner and overnight at Hotel Andrikken or similar.

Day 5: ANDENES / SAFARI BALEINES / SVOLVÆR (210 KM)

After Scandinavian breakfast, Departure for a unique experience. Today we take you on a journey that will bring you closer to whales, and sometimes orcas, who meet in this area during the winter period. This gives you a great opportunity to observe killer whales, humpback whales in full operation.

Whales Warranty: The important activity of whales in the region enables us to guarantee the observation. If due to bad weather (Cancellation), or simply bad luck that if you do not see whales, the activity will be refunded (350 NOK for use locally on an optional excursion). *Tea, coffee and biscuits available throughout the duration of the cruise.*

Departure to Svolvær, the capital of the Lofoten. Overnight in Thon hotel Lofoten or similar.

Day 6: LEKNES / HARSTAD (240 KM)

Scandinavian breakfast. Spend the day exploring the Lofoten Islands, which is a place of great beauty, dominated by towering snowy peaks that end in the sea. Separated from the mainland by the Vestfjord, the islands creates a chain of about 150 km from north to south between minor islands and bays. You will use many bridges and ferries to discover this region. You will discover the lively fishing villages, which in high season are fishing cod. Optional visit to the Fisherman Village

Overnight in Clarion Collection Hotel Arcticus.

Day 7: HARSTAD/HURTIGRUTEN / TROMSØ

At 8 AM you will depart on a cruise from Harstad to Tromsø. The cruise is about 6,5 hours and you will experience breathtaking views along the route. The coastal voyage is synonymous with Norway and is sometimes described as the World's Most Beautiful Sea Voyage.

Overnight at Hotel Thon Tromsø or similar.

Day 8: TROMSØ – DEPARTURE

After Scandinavian breakfast. Transfer on your own to the airport
