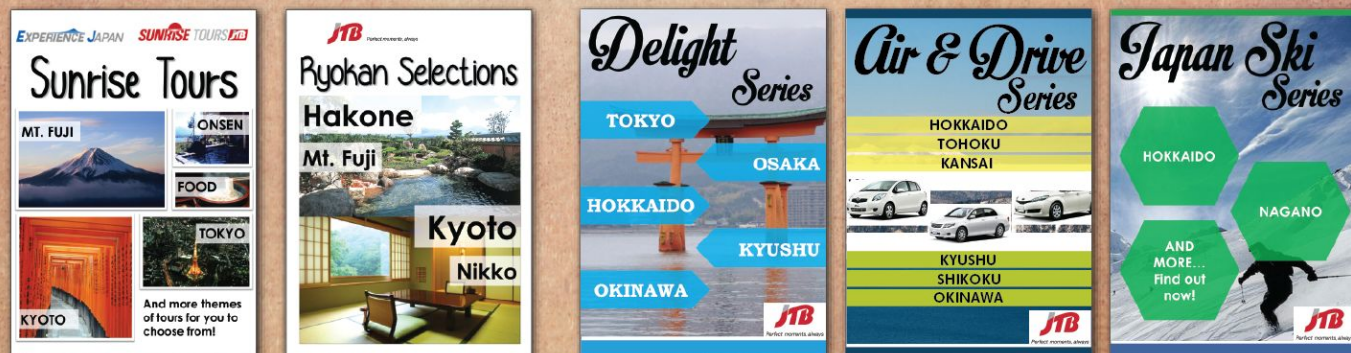

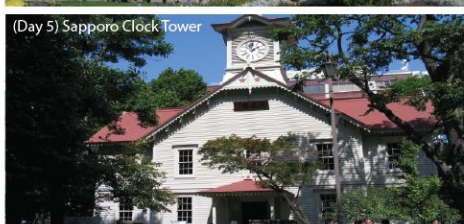
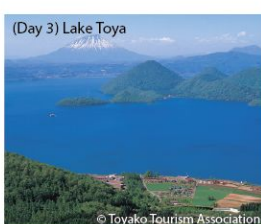

DAY1

Assemble at Changi Airport for Check-in

DAY2

Hakodate 函館

La Vista Hakodate Bay or similar / Western Room

Upon arrival, transfer to local restaurant for lunch (For 8May departure, lunch excluded, Hokkaido snack will be given instead). Visit **Goryokaku Tower (五稜郭)** ✨. This tower is 107m high and its observatory decks command the entire view of Goryokaku Park. From here, you would be able to see the grand Mt. Hakodate and Yokotsu mountain range. Next, enjoy the beautiful blooms at **Goryokaku Park** ✨. This park was a massive, star shaped, Western styled citadel built in the last years of the Edo Period and converted into a public park in 1910s. Over a thousand cherry trees were planted along its moats, making this place one of Hokkaido's best cherry blossom spots. After that, proceed to **Motomachi (元町)**, a district favored by foreign residents who settled in Hakodate when Japan's era of isolation came to an end in 1854. As such, many buildings of foreign influences still exist in the area. With sloping streets and stylish western buildings, Motomachi provides a picturesque backdrop for

ample photo opportunities. If time permits, proceed to **Hakodate Bay Area**, known for the old red brick warehouses that houses a number of shops and restaurants and offers spectacular night views. Enjoy dinner and thereafter end the night on **Mt. Hakodate Ropeway** and be mesmerized by the famous nightscape of Hakodate.

DAY3

Hakodate – Lake Toya 函館 – 洞爺湖

Toya Nono Kaze or similar / Western Room

This morning, stroll around **Hakodate Morning Market (函館朝市)**. It has more than 200 stores and sells delicious food from Hakodate such as marine produce, vegetables, fruit, sweets and chinmi (processed seafood). After that, let the delicate beauty of cherry blossom flowers awaken your senses at **Aoba Park (青葉)** ✨. After lunch at the local restaurant, proceed to **Mt. Showa (昭和 新山)**, one of Japan's youngest mountains. This mountain suddenly rose from a flat wheat field to its current height of 290 m between 1943-1945. Named after Emperor Showa (1926-1989), this mountain is still venting sulfurous fumes today. You can get good views of the young volcano as well as of **Lake Toya** by taking the **Mt. Usu Ropeway (有珠山)**. Tonight, enjoy a sumptuous buffet at the hotel restaurant.

DAY4

Lake Toya – Noboribetsu – Furano
洞爺湖 – 登別 – 富良野

New Furano Prince or similar / Western Room

This morning, visit **Usu Zenkoji Temple (有珠善光寺)** ✨. Designated as a National Important Cultural Asset, it is also a famous cherry blossom viewing spot. Continue your journey to **Noboribetsu Hell Valley (登別地獄谷)**. It's an explosion crater of Mt. Kuttara and about 10,000 tons of hot spring in various kinds is gushes out daily. The views of boiling and bubbling water make Japanese visitors imagine Hell where demons live. After lunch at the local restaurant, visit **Noboribetsu Date Jidaimura (登別伊達時代村)**, a history theme park highlighting the Edo Period. Step back in time, mingle with the Ninja and Oiran and enjoy the charm of ancient Japan. Thereafter, leave for Furano (3.5 hrs). If the cherry trees blossom very well, you will have a **Photo Stop at Todai Enshu Rin (東大演習林)** ✨ enroute.

Upon arrival, hotel check in and enjoy **Japanese Kaiseki Dinner** at the hotel restaurant. If you finish dinner early, take a stroll around the **Ningle Terrace** next to the hotel. (Close at 8.45pm). It is a beautiful collection of boutique cottages, housing specialty arts and crafts along with their creators. The creators sit there in the shops displaying and making more of their products as you wander around.

DAY5

Furano – Asahikawa – Sapporo
富良野 – 旭川 – 札幌

Hotel Okura or similar / Western Room

This morning, Have a **Photo Stop at Miyama Sakura En* (深山さくら園)** ✨ which is famous for its Cherry Blossom. Next, visit **Shikisai Hill (四季彩の丘)** ✨, a large flower gardens on a rolling hill which provides you a stunning view of the surrounding areas. Thereafter, head to **Asahikawa (旭川)** via the **Scenic Patchwork Road**. Today's lunch is at **Asahikawa Ramen Village (旭川ラーメン村)** where eight of Asahikawa's most well-known ramen shops gathers (at own expenses). Next, visit **Otokoyama Sake Brewery (男山酒造)**. With 340 years history, it is one of the oldest Sake Brewery in Japan. Thereafter, transfer to Sapporo. You will Pass by the **Clock Tower (時計台)**, which is the symbol of Sapporo. Tonight, enjoy a **luxury Crab Kaiseki dinner** at the local restaurant.

DAY6

Sapporo – Otaru – Sapporo 札幌 – 小樽 – 札幌

Hotel Okura or similar / Western Room

This morning, transfer to **Otaru (小樽)**. You will enjoy the **Chopsticks Decoration Experience** there. After **Lunch at Otaru Kihin Kan (小樽貴賓館)**, the old Aoyama house, take a stroll along **Otaru Canal (小樽運河)** which has century old stone warehouses by the sides. Continue your journey to **Sakaimachi Street (境町通り)**. Visit the **Kitaichi Glass Shop (北一硝子)** and be fascinated by the high quality glass tableware and artworks created by skilled craftsmen. Then to **Music Box Hall (オルゴール堂)** where beautifully crafted music boxes are displayed for your choice to purchase. Next, transfer back to Sapporo.



DAY7

Sapporo – New Chitose Airport 札幌 – 新千歳空港

On the final day, enjoy free and easy time in the morning. You may visit Sapporo Chuo Market, which is stocked daily with fresh merchandise from the oceans and mountains of Hokkaido! After this, assemble and proceed to **Mitsui Outlet Mall** for last minute shopping. You can enjoy a variety of fashion, food and entertainment options there. Thereafter, you will depart for Singapore from the New Chitose Airport.
