DAY 01 SINGAPORE / SURABAYA

(Meal on Board)
Welcome to **Surabaya!**

You will be transferred to your hotel.

DAY 02 SURABAYA / PROBOLINGGO

(Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)



Begin your Java tour with a photo stop at the **Surabaya Monument**.

Next on the itinerary is **Klenteng Sanggar Agung**. This Chinese temple located in a strategic position overlooking the water. Opposite the temple is the **Four Faced Buddha**. Make a stop at a local **cracker shop** before your lunch.

You will not imagine that you will visit a Russian sub-marine but this is exactly what is on show at **Monumen Kapal Selam**. The submarine was used by the Indonesian navy until it was decommissioned in 1990.

DAY 03 PROBOLINGGO / PRIGEN

(Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)



Set off in the early hours to be ready to witness the **Mt Bromo sunrise**. Return to your hotel for breakfast.

Check out for your onward journey to **Prigen**. Arrived in your African style resort with the rest of the day free at leisure. You may try your hands feeding the cute **Meerkats** or partake in the activities organised by the resort.

Warm clothing and mask is required for visiting Mt Bromo / Sunrise subject to weather conditions

DAY 04 PRIGEN / MOJOKERTO / SOLO

(Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)

Meet the youngest animals, have a picture with young Orang Utans, white and the endangered Sumatran tigers, African Lion. Watch the Orang Utans,

Chimpanzee, Proboscis Monkeys and more as they swing from branch to branch in their unique cultural settings etc at **Taman Safari**.

Continue your sightseeing of the old capital of the Majapahit Kingdom - **Candi Tikus** or ritual bath pool in Trowulan village. Thanks to Sir Thomas Stamford Raffles that this ancient city ruins were discovered in the 19th century.

Continue to **Solo**.

DAY 05 SOLO / YOGYAKARTA

(Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)
Set off for **Yogyakarta**.

Your tour in Yogyakarta brings you to the Unesco **Prambanan Temple**. Built in the middle of the 9th century, some 50 years after Borobudur, the temple is Indonesia's largest Hindu site comprising of the remains of some 244 temples.

It's time for shopping at the main **Malioboro** shopping street before checking into your hotel.

DAY 06 YOGYAKARTA / MAGELANG / YOGYAKARTA / SINGAPORE

(Breakfast / Lunch)



Not to be missed is the famous Unesco site of **Borobudur**. This famous Buddhist temple dating from the 8th and 9th centuries was built in 3 tiers, a pyramidal base with 5 concentric square terraces, the trunk of a cone with 3 circular platforms and at the top a monumental stupa.
