
Smiling Lion Cultural Village is located on the west side of Tianfu International Airport of New Eastern District of Chengdu. The total planning

### **OUNKNOWN CULTURE**


#### • THE FORGOTTEN CULTURAL HERITAGE

The village was the old site of Pingquan County of Ancient Kingdom of Shu 1000 years ago. The name of "Pingquan" is due to the story of Bieling who solved the flood problem, so the place is also known as "Noah's Ark of Ancient Kingdom of Shu".

The area has a rich cultural heritage such as Three fish Stone Carving of Han Dynasty(202 B.C. -220 B.C.), the biggest stone lion sculpture in Asia and the ancient Painted stone grotto of Qing Dynasty (1636-1912) .


#### UNKNOWN HISTORICAL CELEBRITY

The area also has many beautiful stories that live on today. Wang Guipu, the first zhuangyuan of Tang Dynasty in Ancient China was born here. He wrote the poem of "White Horse Courtyard" to describe his reading scene becomes an important textual material to restore the physical environment. (Zhuanyuan: the top scorer of the official exam in ancient China.)











Question: how to better protect the cultural heritage and make the history wellkown again?



### **⊚ DEVELOPMENT RESTRICTION** ★★


#### BROKEN MOUNTAIN:

Part of the mountain must be cut in order to meet the aviation height limit.




#### **AIRPORT DRAINAGE:**

 Large tracts of farmland are barren due to lack of cultivation because the villagers moved out.





### STRATEGY 2: CULTURAL REVITALIZATION



#### PRESERVATION OF TANGIBLE CULTURAL HERITAGE

#### ■ STEP1: ARTIFACTS CLEAN-UP

Professionals from the cultural protection department utilize modern technology to remove dirty things accumulated over years also add surface protection layer to better protect these artifacts.

#### ■ STEP2: FENCE PROTECTION

Choose glass and stone fence to avoid direct contact by tourist. Add introduction boards to make the information easier for visitors to read.



## ■ STEP3: SUITABLE SHELTER

Demolish the dilapidated brick house and build a wooden pavilion to better protect the painted stone Grottoes from moisture and direct sunshine. Use 3D laser scanning to record the pictures.



### **INHERITANCE OF INTANGIBLE CULTURAL HERITAGE**

#### ■ STEP 1: TEXTUAL RESEARCH

Find out the story happened here according to historical documents, It's the born place of Wang Guipu, the first Zhuanyuan in Jianzhou's history who wrote a poem to describe the scenery.



#### ■ STEP 2: RESTORE THE STORY SCENE

Restore the scene of the story according to the historical documents and placed visitors to historical scenes to learn from ancestors also gain enlightenments.



#### ■ STEP 3: SPIRITUAL CONNATION

Endow the place and guide visitors with spiritual connotation to make wishes for wonderful things.


#### ADAPTIVE REUSE OF VERNACULAR DEWELLINGS



The "lovely smile" of the stone lion is the inspiration source to design creative cultural product in order to make more people know the special culture.




