Is Participation important?

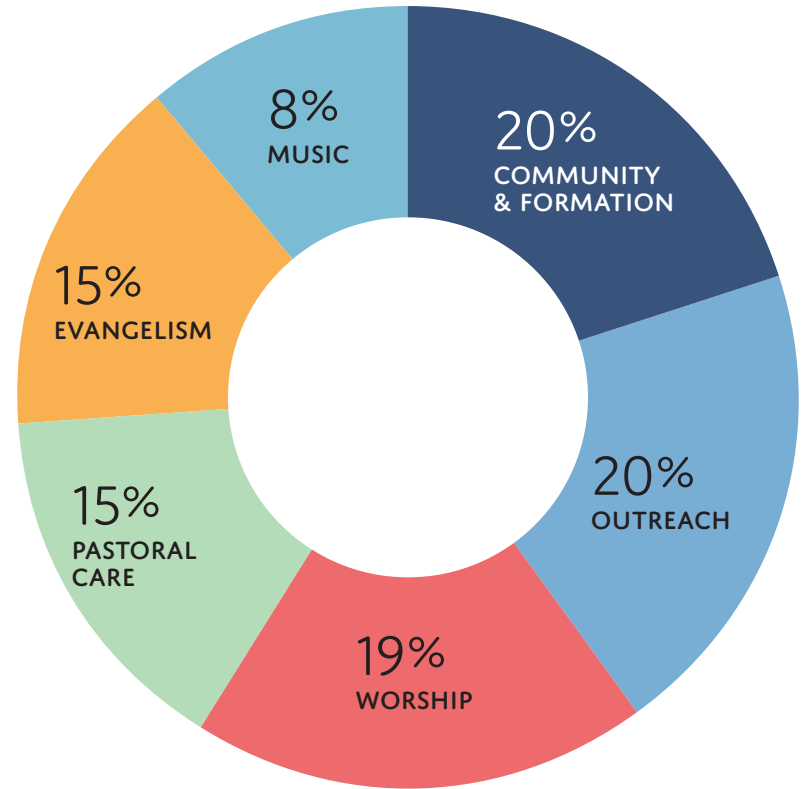
Every member counts and every pledge brings us closer to reaching our goal for the campaign. Our bond of faith is strengthened through everyone's participation, in work, prayer, and sharing.

Through every family's participation in the campaign, we are able to provide for the vast majority of the annual budget—64 percent—that comes from our Every Member Canvass and parishioner contributions.

The Cathedral Endowment Fund also contributes 25 percent, and the rest comes from revenue sources such as the Cathedral House Episcopal School, Treebeards restaurant, and our parking garage.
